REPORT

- e. <u>Incubation and Funding Support</u>: The government has established incubation centres and funds to provide mentoring, infrastructure, and financial assistance to start-ups.
- f. Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Protection: The scheme includes initiatives to promote awareness about IPR and provide legal support to start-ups in filing and protecting their intellectual property.
