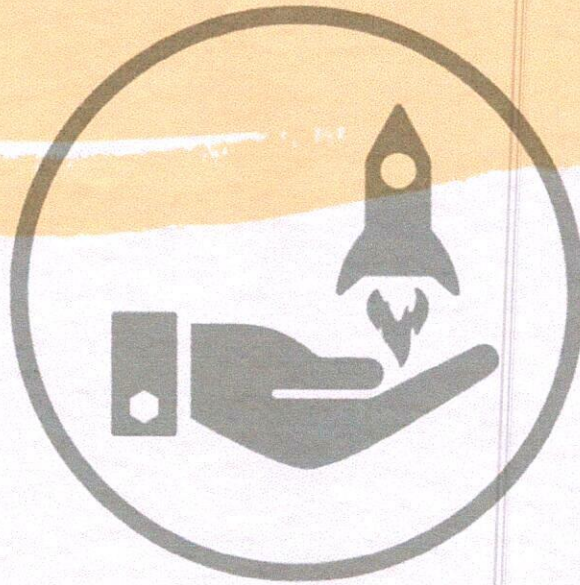

**REPORT**
