



Report on one-day industry visit to Printing Press

Mumbai, 8th Dec 2022: The BAMMC Department of Shree L.R Tiwari Degree College of Arts, Science and Commerce organized a one-day industrial visit to Indian Express Printing Press located at Mahape. The students of FY and SY accompanied by their department faculties namely Asst. Prof Ajay yadav and Asst. Prof Moumita Nath visited the plant on 8th Dec, 2022. All the students had submitted their consent forms duly signed by their parents a day before.

The students were excited to visit the plant as they gained practical knowledge about the different methods and techniques of newspaper and magazine printing. In an interaction with the General Manager of the plant, the students and faculties got to know more details about the Indian Express Printing press as well as its Marathi Version LokSatta's working hours and the overall status of print media in Indian scenario. The GM of the plant, Mr. Nilesh Kherdekar described the detailed functioning of the plant and bulk production of the plant that caters to thousands of readers all across the country. However, he also mentioned about the declining status of printing press in an era of digital technology. He further stated that in next 25 years down the line, the digital media might completely take over the print media.

The students were guided by the technicians and staffs of the plant and briefed them about the imported machines, paper rolls, printing colours etc. The paper rolls are imported from Scandinavian countries, Russia and China. It seems the growing expenses of such imported materials due to rising dollar prices, pandemic aftermath and Russian war has also impacted the industry. The staffs also mentioned that only printing is carried out in the plant having received the print layout from respective newspaper organizations. Per hour 30-35 thousand copies are printed by the machines. The colour scheme of printing for newspaper and magazines is CMYK (Cyan, Magenta, Yellow and Key Black) and half tone ink is used. It has also been mentioned by the staffs that since the humble beginnings of the plant till date the plant have been continuously printing day in and day out meeting the bulk requirements on a daily basis. However, it was during the pandemic, that the plant was not functioning for 7 days in a row and is considered as a black period in the history of the plant.

The eventful day culminated with in-depth learning about the entire production process involved in newspaper and magazine printing. The students headed back to college and thereafter dispersed after reporting to their department coordinator.

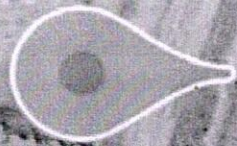

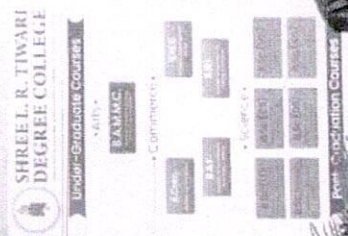

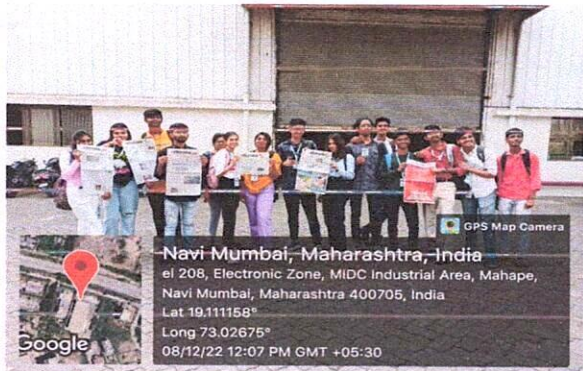
