NSS CAMP ACTIVITIES:-

FIRST DAY OF CAMP: INUAGURATION OF THE CAMP Date: 06-01-2020

The camp began with the inaugural function in the College Campus. The programme began with the NSS flag hosting and lightning of lamp at Zillah Parishad School of Kasarali in the presence of the Chief Guests Mr. Raja Ram Patil, the President of Ram Panch Committee, Mr. PrakashVaiti, the treasurer of Ram Panch Committee and Mr. Kishore Kinni, the Secretary of Ram Panch Committee. The NSS song and Mumbai University were played and distribution of the NSS badges to all volunteers was carried by the chief guests.

Mr. Raja Ram Patil and Dr. Chetana Shah, Principal, delivered the inaugural address. He discussed the various factors affecting the dignity and role of women in society. He also gave an elaborative presentation on the reasons increasing of crime against women which becomes social evil. The Village authority welcomed the team of NSS volunteers and assured them all sorts of cooperation needed in making the special camp a success.

- ➤ Post inauguration session, different groups were formed by Prof. ChiragChandan (NSS PO) for performing the task throughout the camping session.
- Various groups were formed and the students were divided into five teams and the responsibilities were explained to them.

After the breakfast volunteers started the cleanliness program. Starting with the Camp site all the nearby areas of camp were cleaned by the volunteers. Different groups were formed for doing different works. Some were cleaning the campsite some were cleaning the rooms some were busy with cooking food for the volunteers.

The afternoon of the first day, first session was conducted on the social skit plays. The session was led by Prof. JagdishSansare, the NSS Coordinator, Palghar District. The volunteers were overwhelmed from the first session by Prof. Jagdish sir. The session was very interactive and amazing. The volunteers got motivated and inspired for preparing on street plays. He also showed how we can use daily used things such as plates and spoon for interacting and gathering crowd. He also gave an idea how we can use ourselves as different props in play. After that amazing session the volunteers were so inspired that they started practicing for skit play.

- ➤ Post session, different groups were formed by Prof. ChiragChandan (NSS PO) for performing the skit on different topics throughout the camping:
 - 1. SWACHHTA DRIVE
 - 2. WATER CONSERVATION
 - 3. ANTI- ADDICTION (VYASAN MUKTI)
- > There was an introductory session at the evening conducted for the students to introduce themselves to each other and to get rid off stage fear. This platform was successful in enabling the students to speak with confidence.
- > Physical activity was carried out in the Health Centre ground in the evening.
- ➤ Before dinner, a meeting was organized by the Programme Officer to discuss about the day's happening and planning for the next day.

DAY 2:

Date: 07-01-2020

- > The forenoon session began with a morning walk at village which was followed by a yoga session at campsite.
- > The camp site was cleaned by NSS Volunteers by collecting plastic wastes.
- > Volunteers digged a SOAK PIT (sauchkhadda) near camp site for effective water disposal and percolation
- > Awareness drive was also conducted among villagers about Conservation of Water.
- > Cleanliness drive was held at the Zed-P School near campsite.
- > The afternoon session was taken by Prof. ArunaGujjar, NSS Area Cordinator; on "adult literacy programme"
- > In the evening volunteers conducted sporting activities at the campsite.
- > Volunteers had prepared paper and cotton bags with the help of villagers.
- ➤ Before dinner, a meeting was organized by the Programme Officer to discuss about the day's happening and planning for the next day.

DAY 3:

Date: 08-01-2020

- > The forenoon session began with yoga and workout session.
- > The volunteers have prepared multiple SOAK PIT (sauchkhaddas) of around 4ft. in the villagefor percolationwater pouring on the street.
- > Volunteers' shramdaan was noted for repairing and maintenance of Village Street.
- The afternoon session was led by Mr. Anna Kadlaskar, Scientific Engineer (BARC) and founder member of AndhshraddhaNirmulanSamittee, Palghar. This session was conducted for removing superstitions from the mind of volunteers. He showed some tricks and demonstration of superstitious magic conducted to fool the people. All the volunteers pledged that they will never believe in superstitions.
- The evening volunteers met Mr. Bhupendra Mishra, National Awarder's in NSS, the social Entrepreneur and Motivational Speaker. He led the session and motivated us on **CAREER ADVANCEMENT** and addressed volunteers how they can be advanced in his career through NSS.
- ➤ Before dinner, a meeting was organized to discuss about the day's happening and planning for the next day.

DAY 4:

Date: 09-01-2020

- > NSS volunteers taught art and craft to the students of Zed-P School of Kasarali Village.
- ➤ All volunteers have presented their performance in cultural programme which was especially organized for villagers. The Principal of Shree L.R. Tiwari Degree College was also present in the chief guests. All the chief Guests lightened the lamp and started the program by the blessing of God. Volunteers showed their talent in presence of chief guests and the villagers. 5 Dance performances and Fashion show of Boys and girls was performed.
- After all the performances, Principal ma'am and volunteers distributed books and stationery to the students of Zed-P School.

- The afternoon session was conducted on Disaster Management led by Mr. RajanShelar, the Co-founder of Resilience Foundation. He addressed all NSS volunteers on Disaster Management to acknowledge them about emergency. Various demonstrations were also carried through for practical experience. The students of Zed-P school have also attended the session.
- ➤ In the evening, all volunteers started the rally and conducted awareness drive; began from camp site to the village but today's motive was to invite the villagers for the Yoga Session which was supposed to be held in the next morning at the Zed P School.
- A discussion was held after dinner exercise, in which the day's happenings were discussed and the plans for the next day were charted out.

DAY 5:

Date: 10-01-2020

- ➤ The Morning session started by the yoga session at Zed-P School this was led by Mr. Baldev Sing, Patanjali Yoga Sammitee for the volunteers and Kasarali villagers.
- After the breakfast volunteers visited Shipping Industries near Vaitarna Creek. Volunteers have been taught and observed different ship building works and process of Sand collection.
- ➤ Afternoon session followed by filling of SOAK PIT (sauchkhaddas) prepared earlier by bricks ribbit and adequate amount of sands.
- Few volunteers visited at the KasaraliTalao and its vicinity areas in afternoon session. The main motive to visit the was to clean the KasaraliTalao and the surroundings. This cleanliness program was done under the presence of KASARALI SAMMITEE MEMBERS. Volunteers have collected plastic wastes and bottles and cleanliness drive was undertaken to clean water of Talao.
- > Skit Play was performed at KasaraliTalao and its vicinity area to conserve and protect the water of talao through awareness drive.
- ➤ In the evening volunteers started to prepare paper bags to distribute among the villagers.

 The main motive of distributing paper bags was bringing awareness about the anti-plastic environment and use of old papers.
- > Before dinner, a meeting was organized to discuss about the day's happening and planning for the next day.

DAY6:

Date: 11-01-2020

- Morning session was begun with a long walk of around 5km to Dahisar village.
- ➤ All volunteers have made SHRAMDAAN at Bricks Making Industry at near Dahisar Village. The main motive to visit the brick factory was to help the workers working in the factory.
- > Donation of clothes drive was undertaken and new clothes brought by volunteers and faculties were distributed to unprivileged and poor people.
- ➤ While returning towards campsite volunteers visited and took a halt at Zed P School Dahisar Village for teaching and entertaining the students. Distribution of Books, Stationery and Chocolates was also done by the volunteers among the students.
- > Post lunch session was followed by the practice of our Skit play which was supposed to be held at evening at Village Chowk.
- The evening session started with the rally on Anti-Plastic and Swachhta. The skit play was performed by different groups of volunteers on ANTI-PLASTIC, SWACHHTA HI SARVOPARI and ANTI-DRUG ADDICTION, just to create awareness among the villagers.
- After all the skits, paper bags and cotton bags prepared by volunteers were distributed among the villagers and they were informed about the Swachhta Drive and anti-plastic environment.
- > The student coordinators also informed them about the garbage and dirty water at Talao which was cleaned by the volunteers.
- > The villagers have taken pledged with villagers that they will be keeping their surrounding and the village clean and tidy.
- > NSS Volunteers also actively participated in the rally which emphasized the awareness of clean environment and importance of education to girls.
- ➤ Before dinner, a meeting was organized to discuss about the day's happening and planning for the next day.

NSS Volunteers took actively participated in the abhiyan by performing cleanliness drive in village KASARALI as well as camp site. This initiative propagated and instilled the value of dignityof labour in all the students of the campus. INTRODUCTION:

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME popularly known as NSS was launched in Gandhi's Birth Centenary Year 1969, under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports Govt. of India. The scheme was launched simultaneously in 37 Universities involving 40,000 students with primary focus on the development of personality of students through community service and promotion of National solidarity.

In India, the idea of involving students in the task of national service dates back to the times of Mahatma Gandhi, the father of the nation. The central theme which he tried to impress upon his student audience time and again was that they should always keep before them, their social responsibility. The first duty of the students should be, not to treat their period of study as one of the opportunities for indulgence in intellectual luxury, but for preparing themselves for final dedication in the service of those who provided the sinews of the nation with the national goods & services so essential to society. Advising them to form a living contact with the community in whose midst their institution is located, he suggested that instead of undertaking academic research about economic and social disability, the students should do "something positive so that the life of the villagers might be raised to a higher material and moral level".

NSS works on the premise that it is possible to awaken the villagers and slum dwellers to their responsibilities and develop in them the confidence, to tackle their common problems with energy, enthusiasm and in a co-operative spirit, based on mutual aid and self-reliance. The role of students is limited as activists, enablers, catalytic agents with wider communities and as programme aids.

The main objectives of National Service Scheme (NSS) are:

- > Understand the community in which they work.
- > Understand themselves in relation to their community.
- > Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem-solving.
- > Develop among them a sense of social and civic responsibility.
- Utilize their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems.
- > Develop competence required for group-living and sharing of responsibilities.
- ➤ Gain skills in mobilizing community participation.
- Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes.
- > Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters and
- > Practice national integration and social harmony.



MOTO of NSS "NOT ME, BUT YOU" reflects the essence of democratic living andupholds the need for selfless service and appreciation of the other person's point of view and also to show consideration for fellow human beings. It underlines that the welfare of an individual is ultimately dependent on the welfare of society on the whole. Therefore, it should be the aim of the NSS to demonstrate this motto in its day-to-day programme.

SPECIAL DAY NSS CAMPING: Special Camping forms an integral part of NationalService Scheme. It has special appeal to the youth as it provides unique opportunities to the students for group living, collective experience sharing and constant interaction with community.

The primary objectives of the special camping programmes are:

- Making education more relevant to the present situation to meet the felt needs of the communities and supplement the education of university/college/school students by bringing them face to face with the community situation.
- ➤ To provide opportunities to students to play their due roles in the implementation of various development programmes by planning and executing development projects, which not only help in creating durable community assets in rural areas and slums but also result in improvement of the condition of weaker sections of the communities.
- ➤ Encouraging the students and non-students youth to work along with the adults in rural areas, thereby developing their character, social consciousness and commitment, discipline and healthy and helpful attitudes towards the community.
- ➤ Building up potential youth leaders by exploring the latent potential among the campers, both students as well as local youth (rural and urban), with a view to involve them more intimately in development projects for longer periods. The local leadership generated during the camps would also be useful in ensuring proper maintenance of the assets created as a result of the camps.
- > Emphasizing the dignity of labour and self-help and the need for combining physical work with intellectual pursuits, and
- > Encouraging youth to participate enthusiastically in the process of national development, and promote national integration through democratic living and cooperative action.




