3. To Examine the availability of technology and vocational training programs that contribute to the skill development and future employability of visually impaired students.


Outcome of the activity

3. Participants identified Introduction of vocational training programs and the establishment of partnerships with companies and organizations to provide opportunities for skill development and future employment.




Conclusion:
