## Report of a seminar conducted on "Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning"

An Orientation Programme on Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning for B.Sc.I.T., B.Sc.C.S., and B.Sc.D.S. students was held at Shree L. R. Tiwari Degree College of Arts, Commerce, and Science on June 22, 2023, from 9:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. in collaboration with VOIS (Campaign run by EDUNET).

Respected Principal Dr. Sanjay Mishra delivered the topic's introduction to the intended audience and discussed the advantages of the VOIS campaign sponsored by EDUNET for degree-seeking college students who are pursuing careers in technical fields. Additionally, Ms. Huda Petkar and Ms. Sonam Gautam, third-year students, provided a brief introduction of the guest.

During the orientation program, Resource Person successfully guided students about a wide range of AI and ML courses offered by VOIS on their online platforms by providing a comprehensive overview of the courses and certifications, students were equipped with the necessary information to make informed decisions about their learning paths. 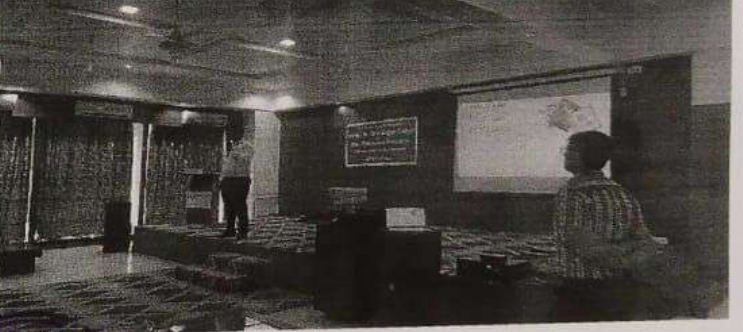

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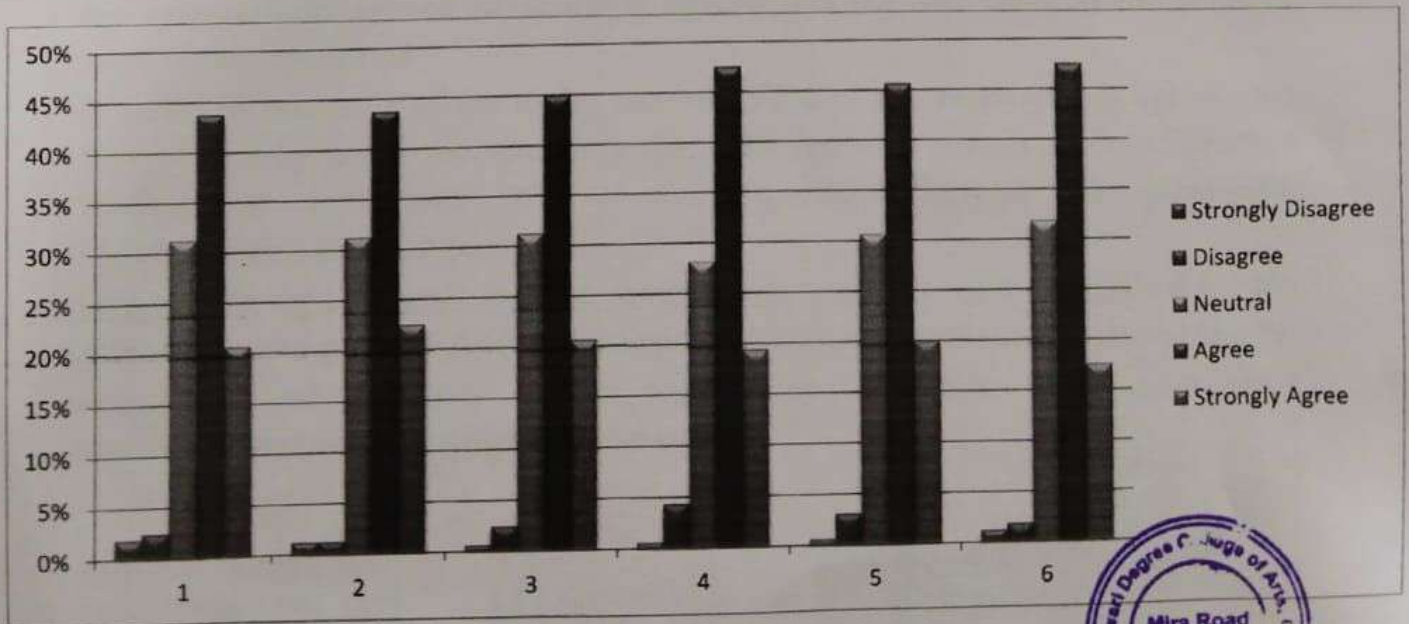
## Students Feedback Analysis of a seminar on “Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning”


#### Interpretation:

Overall the data indicates that the majority of respondents had **positive perceptions** of the seminar's arrangement, clarity of objectives, relevance of the topics, time allocation, knowledge of the resources person, and encouragement of the interaction. However, there were also notable percentages of respondents who remained neutral on these statements. Additionally, there were small percentages of respondents who expressed disagreement or strong disagreement on certain aspects.



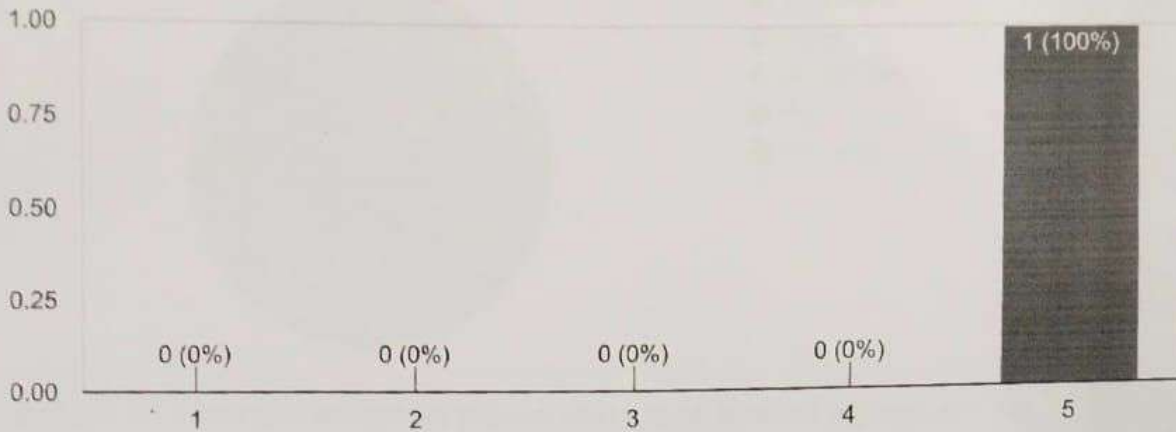

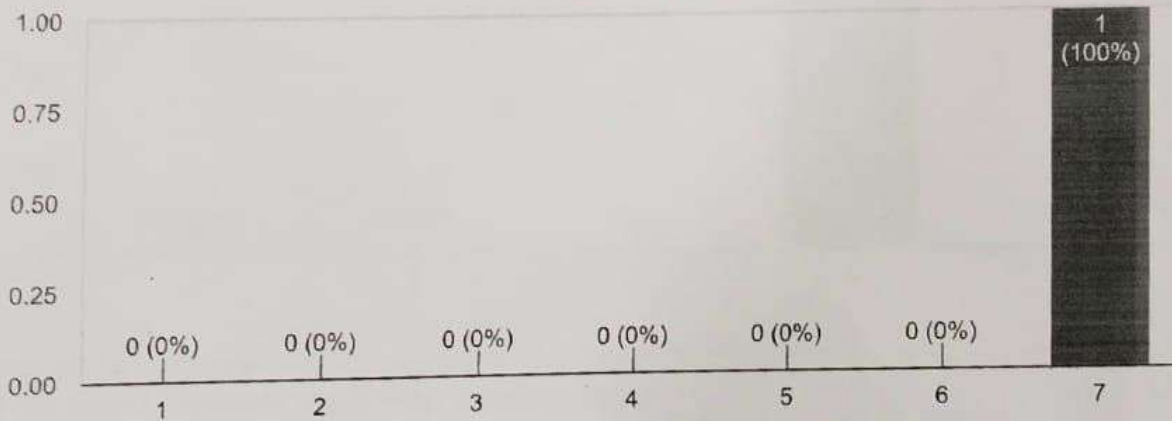

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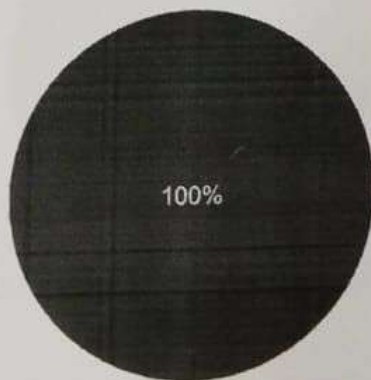

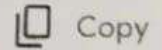

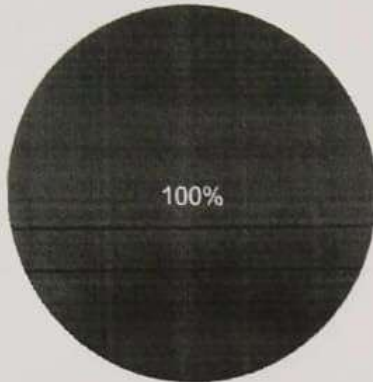




How much pre-event/webinar/seminar information was provided to you to help you better understand the event/webinar?

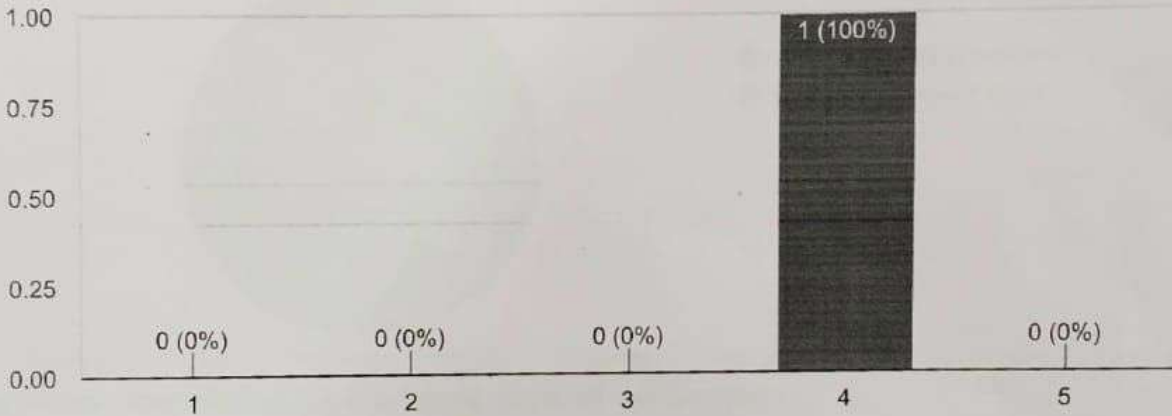

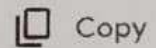
On a scale of 5 being the highest please state your level of agreement for the statement: The duration of the event/seminar was just right for you.



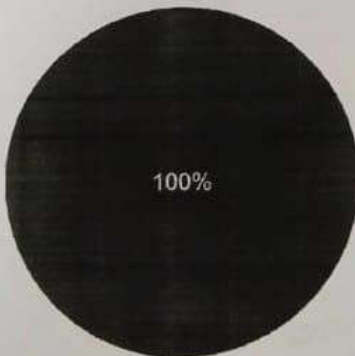

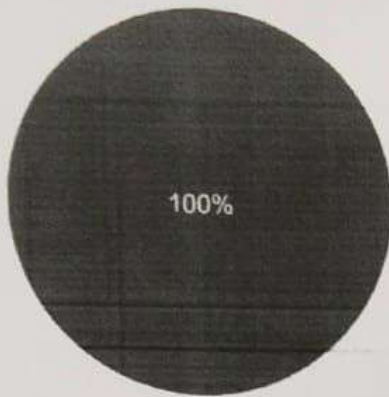

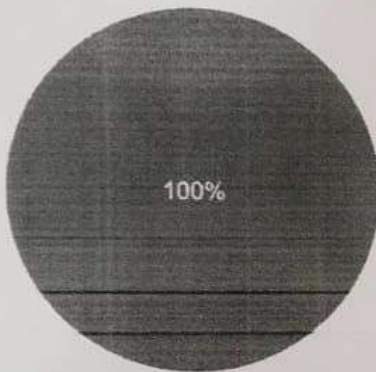
