Outcomes:



Conclusion:

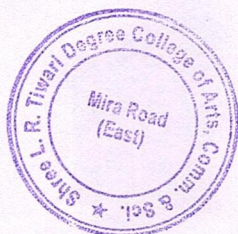

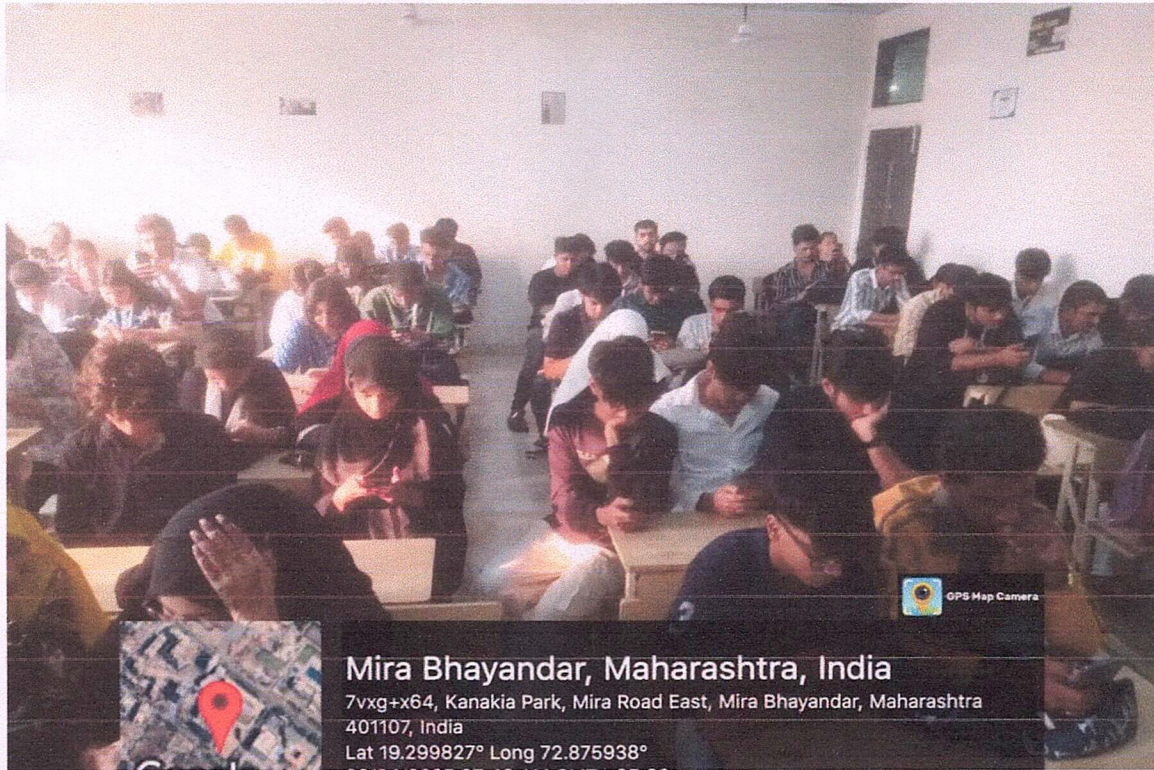
