



#### Q. 3 How would you rate your overall experience at the session?



#### Q.4 How relevant and useful was the information provided in the session?



Inferences: The pie chart presents the participants' assessment of the relevance and usefulness of the information provided in the session. A significant majority (60.8%) rated the information as "Very Useful," indicating that the session effectively delivered valuable insights. Additionally, 17.7% found it "Somewhat Useful," while 21.5% remained "Neutral," suggesting that the session was informative but may have varied in impact based on individual expectations. Notably, there is no visible representation of the "Not Useful" category, implying that most attendees recognized the session's value. Overall, the data reflects a largely positive reception, with room for slight improvements to enhance engagement for all participants.



An overwhelming majority, 94.9%, responded "YES," indicating that the session was highly impactful and successfully inspired attendees to explore these areas further.
