
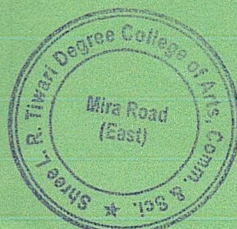

The session is organized by the **Equal Opportunity Cell** of the college as part of its student support initiatives.

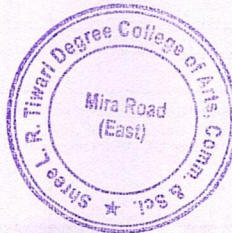

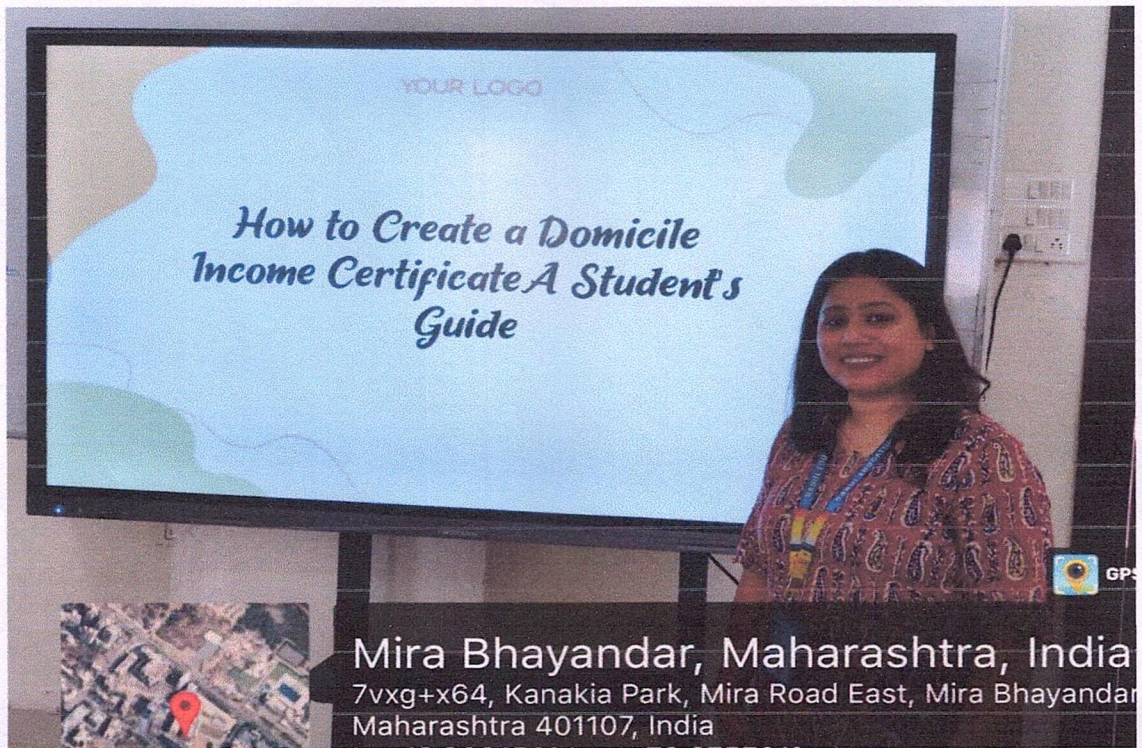
