





1. Overview

The Department of B.Sc. (Data Science), in collaboration with industry partner Edept, organized an industrial visit for SYBSc students to Momentum Metropolitan Pvt Ltd. - Areas Noted with Mixed Responses:
 - o Interaction Opportunities: A few students rated this as "Agree" or "Neutral".
 - o Time Management: Two "Disagree" ratings suggest minor dissatisfaction with scheduling or session length.

4. Qualitative Observations

- Engagement: Most students found the speakers engaging and insightful.
- Clarity: Presentations were clear and helped students visualize industrial applications of their coursework.
- Learning Outcomes: Many students reported a better understanding of how companies manage data operations and analytics.
- **Professional Exposure:** This was especially valuable to SYBSc students who already had foundational knowledge.

5. Recommendations

- **Deep Dive Sessions:** Offer a more technical breakdown for SY students, such as use cases or case study walkthroughs.
- **Q&A Expansion:** Allocate more time for direct interaction with company professionals.
- Follow-up Activity: Consider a post-visit reflection report or class discussion to reinforce learning.

6. Conclusion

The feedback from SYBSc Data Science students was overwhelmingly positive, with over 97% of responses falling under "Strongly Agree" or "Agree." This visit significantly contributed to enhancing students' practical understanding of data science applications and fostered professional curiosity.
