

- Startup Spark: An entrepreneurial pitch event where students presented innovative business ideas to a panel of judges.

- **BGMI:** A battle royale-style game where squads fought to be the last team standing.
- PES: A football simulation game where participants showcased their strategic gameplay and virtual soccer skills.
- Free Fire: An intense survival shooting game where players battled in teams and solo for ultimate victory.



## Q.2 THE ARRANGEMENT & YOUR EXPERIENCE REGARDING THE EVENT WAS?



Inferences: The pie chart presents feedback on the arrangement and overall experience of the event, reflecting participants' satisfaction levels. A significant portion, 45.8%, rated their experience as "Excellent," indicating a highly positive response to the event's organization. "Good" follows with 25%, showing that a substantial number of attendees were satisfied but saw room for improvement. "Neutral" responses account for 12.5%, suggesting that some participants had an average experience. Meanwhile, 16.7% rated it as "Very Poor," highlighting concerns that should be addressed for future improvements. Notably, no respondents rated the event as "Poor," indicating that while some dissatisfaction existed, the majority of attendees had a favourable or neutral experience. ## Q. 3 WAS THE EVENT SCHEDULE WELL-STRUCTURED AND EASY TO FOLLOW?



Inferences: The pie chart illustrates respondents' feedback on whether the event schedule for TECHNOVA 2K25 was well-structured and easy to follow. A majority, 54.2%, responded with "Yes," indicating that more than half of the participants found the schedule well-organized and clear. However, 25% remained "Neutral," suggesting that while they did not face major difficulties, they were not entirely convinced about its effectiveness. Meanwhile, 20.8% responded with "No," highlighting that a portion of attendees found the schedule either unclear or difficult to follow. These insights suggest that while the event was generally well-structured, there is room for improvement in ensuring better clarity and accessibility of the schedule to enhance the experience for all participants in future editions.
