Conclusion:



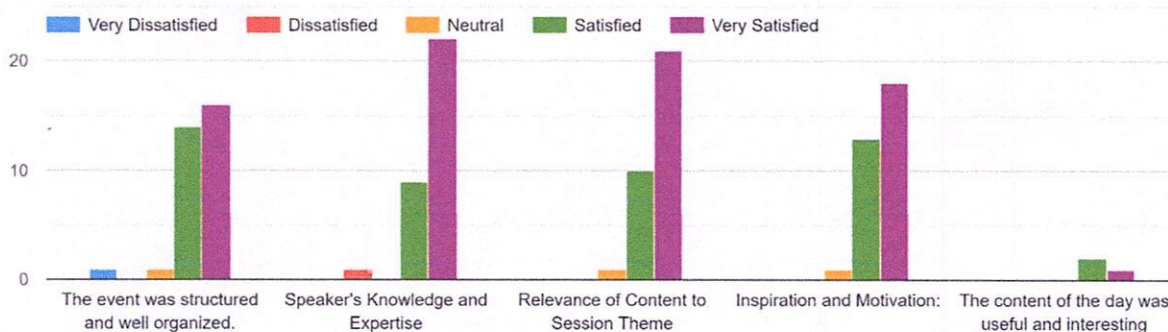

Inferences:

The feedback from respondents indicates an overwhelmingly positive response to the session, with the majority expressing being "very satisfied" across key areas. The event was praised for its structured and well-organized format, while the speaker's knowledge and expertise were highly appreciated. The session's content was found to be both useful and engaging, resonating well with participants and earning high satisfaction. Additionally, the session provided inspiration and motivation, leaving a lasting impact on attendees. Although the relevance of content to the session theme received a slightly lower, yet still positive,





"satisfied" rating from most, the overall feedback highlights the session's success and effectiveness, with minor scope for enhancing content alignment.

Q. 2. Was the session content relevant to your academic and research needs?

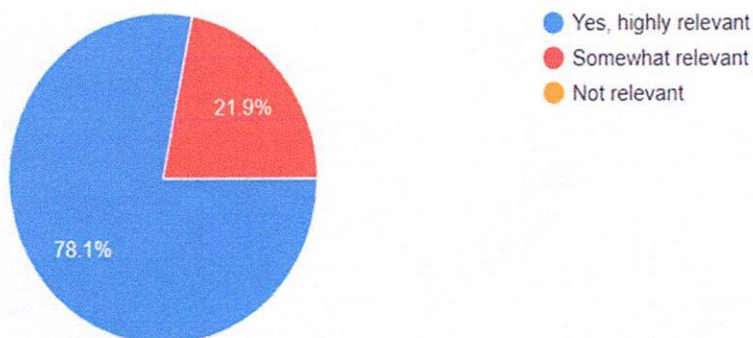

Inferences:

The session was highly relevant to the academic and research needs of the majority of respondents, with 78.1% indicating it was "highly relevant" and 21.9% finding it "somewhat relevant." Notably, none of the participants felt the session was irrelevant, highlighting its strong alignment with their expectations and requirements. This feedback underscores the session's success in addressing participants' academic and research interests, showcasing its value and effectiveness in meeting their needs.

Q. 3. Were the strategies for identifying and applying for project grants clearly explained?

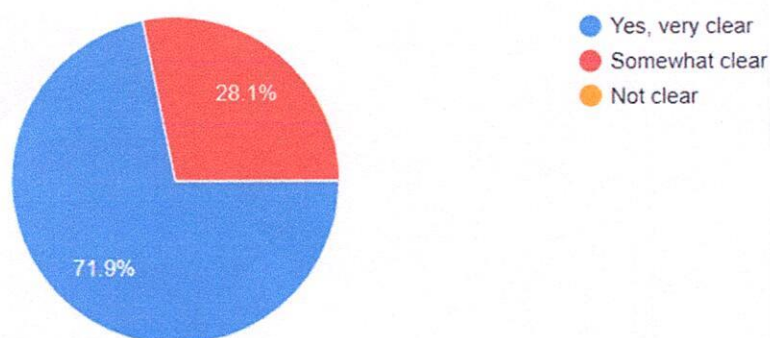

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Inferences:

The session's strategies for identifying and applying for project grants were well-received by the participants, with 71.9% of faculty members stating that the strategies were "very clear," while 28.1% found them "somewhat clear." Notably, none of the respondents felt the session was unclear, indicating that the content was effectively communicated and met the expectations of the audience. This feedback highlights the session's clarity and usefulness in providing actionable insights for project grant applications.

Q. 4. Was the speaker knowledgeable and able to address participants' queries?

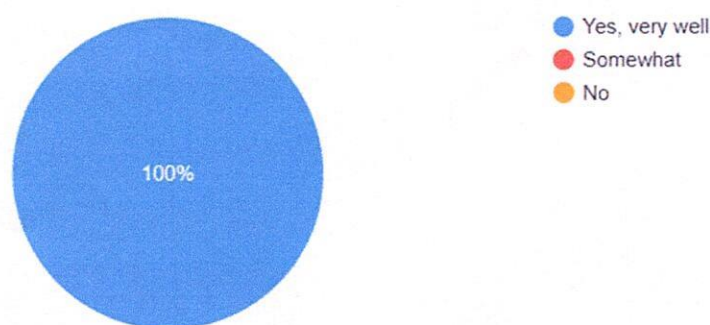

Inferences :

The feedback indicates unanimous agreement among the participants, with 100% of faculty members affirming that the speaker was highly knowledgeable and effectively addressed their queries. None of the respondents expressed any dissatisfaction or ambiguity regarding the speaker's ability to handle questions, underscoring the speaker's expertise and the session's effectiveness in meeting participants' expectations.

Q. 5. Did the session cover practical aspects of grant writing (e.g., proposal structure, funding criteria, etc.)?

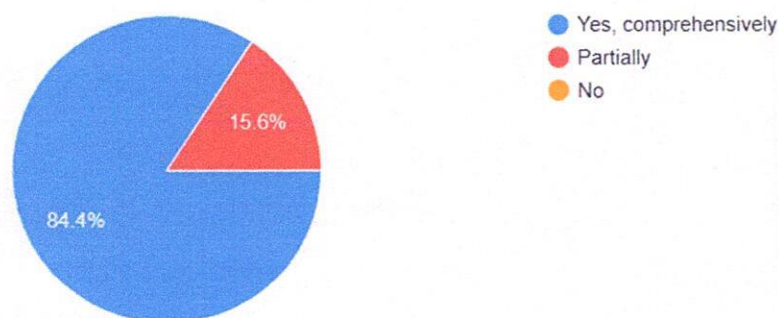

Inference:

The session effectively covered the practical aspects of grant writing, including proposal structure and funding criteria, as reflected in the feedback. A significant majority of 84.4% of participants comprehensively agreed that these aspects were well-addressed, while 15.6% partially agreed. Notably, none of the respondents disagreed, indicating that the session successfully met participants' expectations in delivering practical and relevant insights on grant writing.

Q. 6. Was the online mode of delivery convenient and effective?

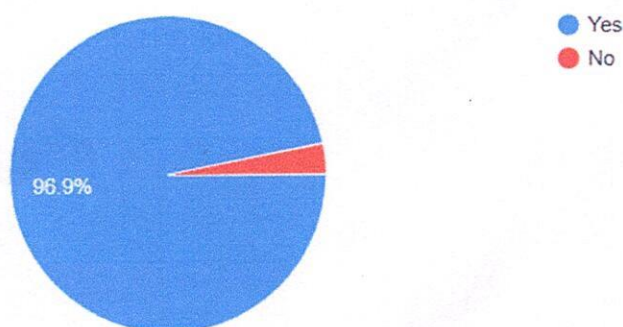

Inference:

The feedback indicates that the online mode of delivery was highly convenient and effective for the majority of participants, with 96.9% expressing satisfaction. However, 3.1% of respondents preferred offline sessions, suggesting they found offline delivery more suitable. Overall, the data highlights the success of the online format in meeting participants' needs while acknowledging a small preference for offline sessions among a few attendees.

Q. 7 Would you recommend similar sessions for future?

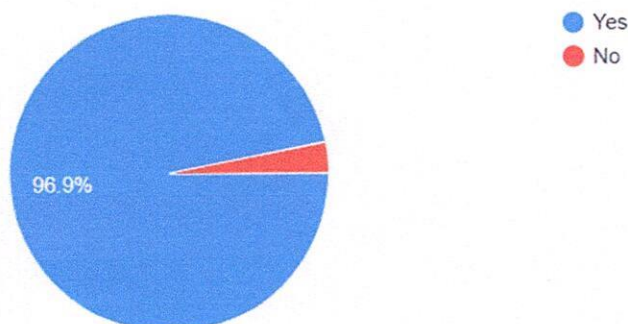

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Inferences:

The majority of faculty members, 96.9%, expressed their willingness to recommend similar sessions for the future, highlighting the session's value and impact. However, a small minority of 3.1% indicated that they would not recommend such sessions. This overwhelmingly positive response underscores the session's effectiveness and relevance, with only a minimal scope for differing preferences.

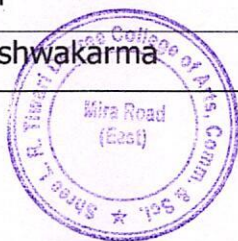
