- The session encouraged participants to adopt a proactive approach to challenges and decision-making.


Conclusion

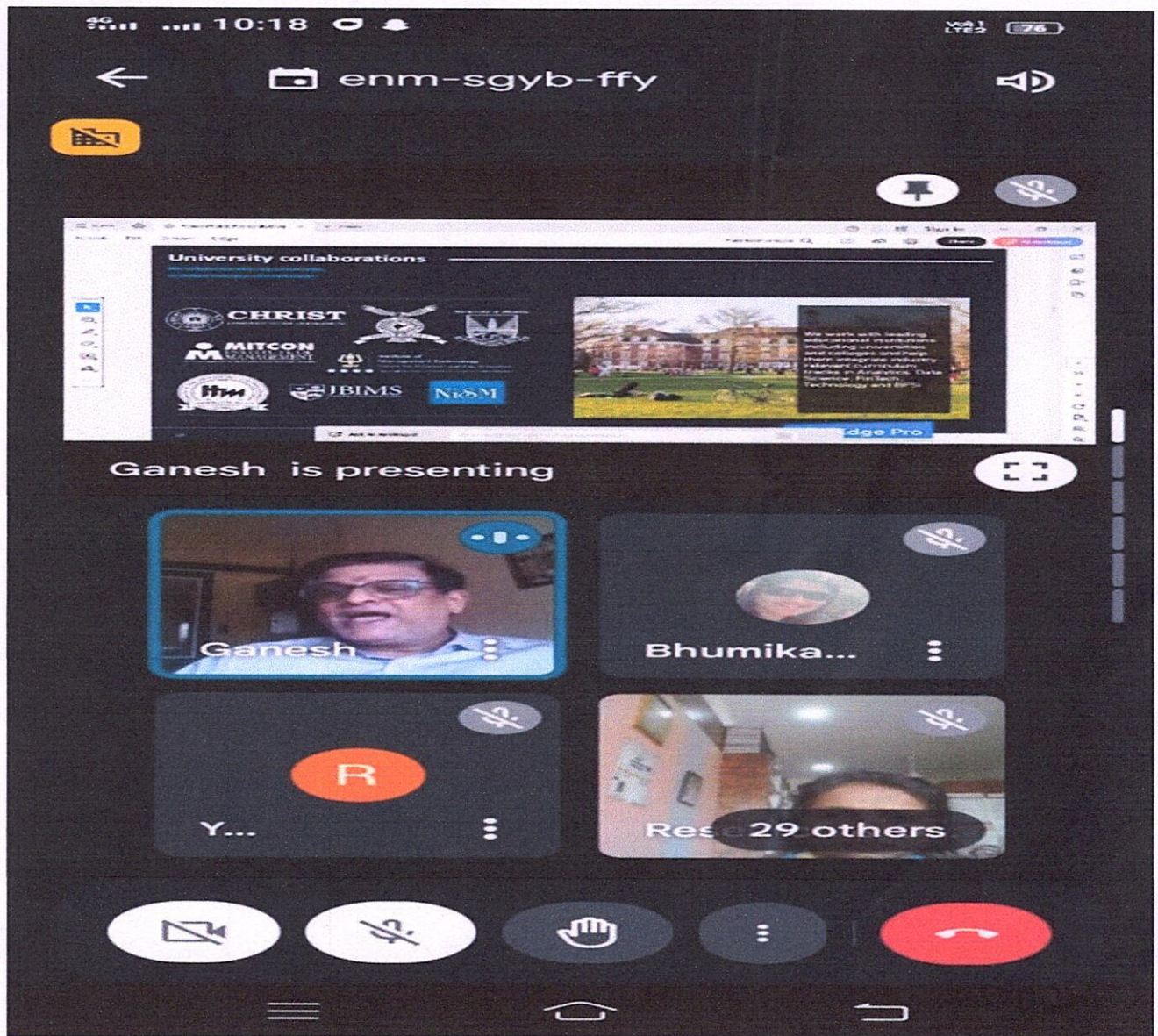

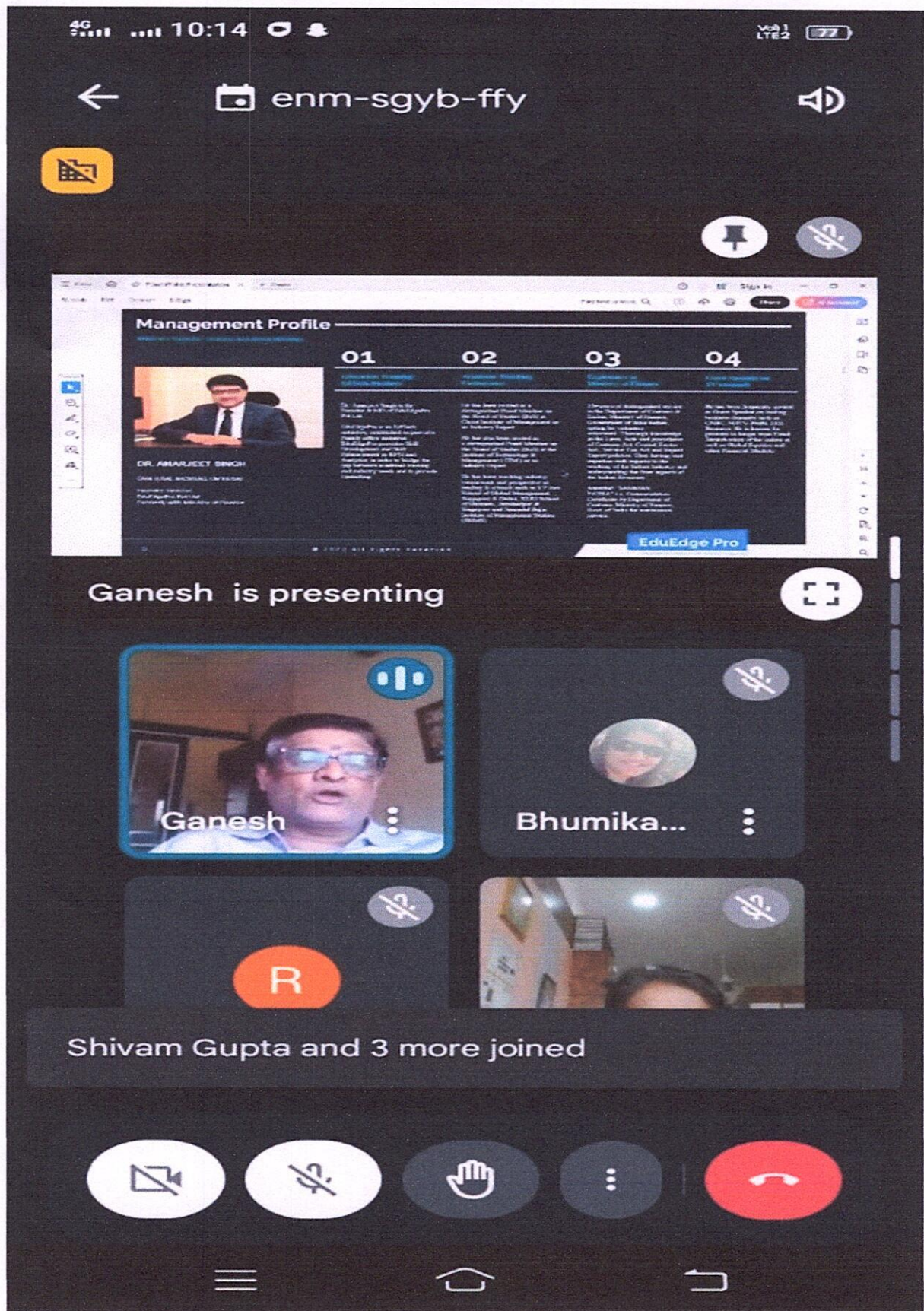

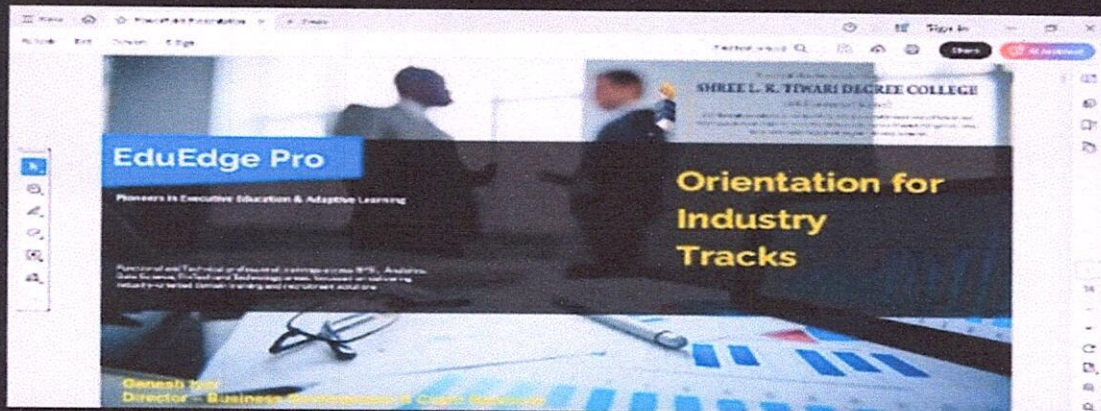

How would you rate the diversity and expertise of the Speaker person ?

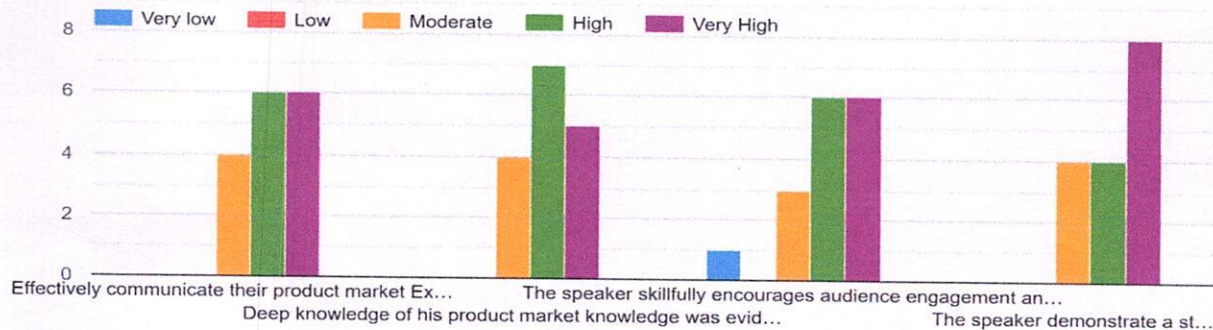

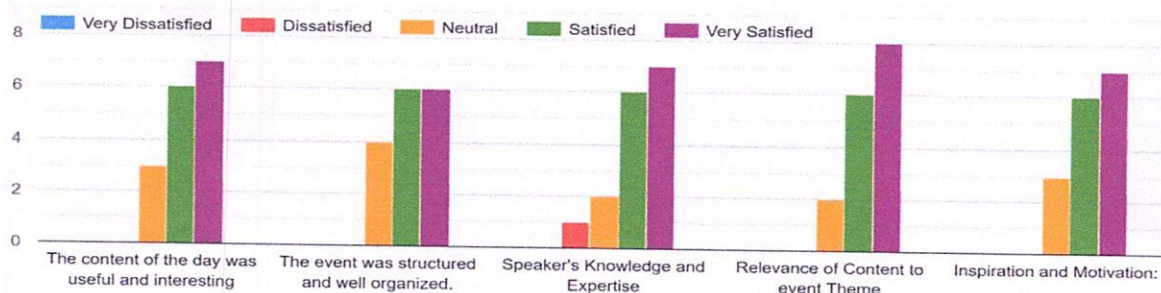

Q.4 How relevant and useful was the information provided in the session?

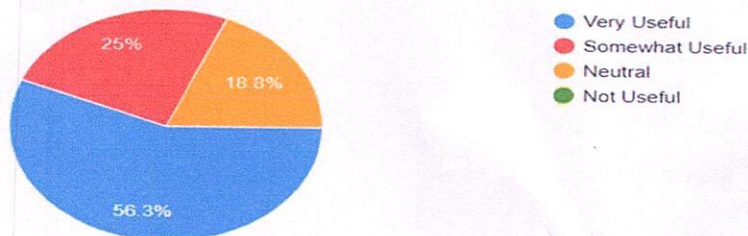

Q.5 "Has this session The "Problem solving and Ideation Workshop" motivated you to consider these fields more seriously for your future endeavours



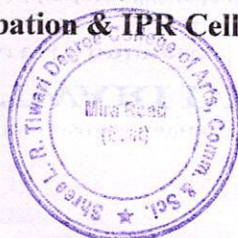

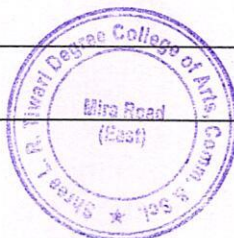
