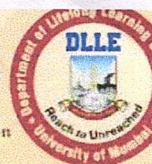

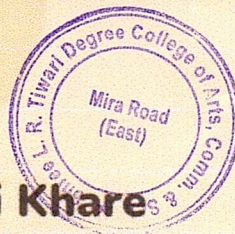

- **Practical Solutions:** The showcased creations offered practical examples of how waste materials can be reused, inspiring attendees to adopt similar practices.


