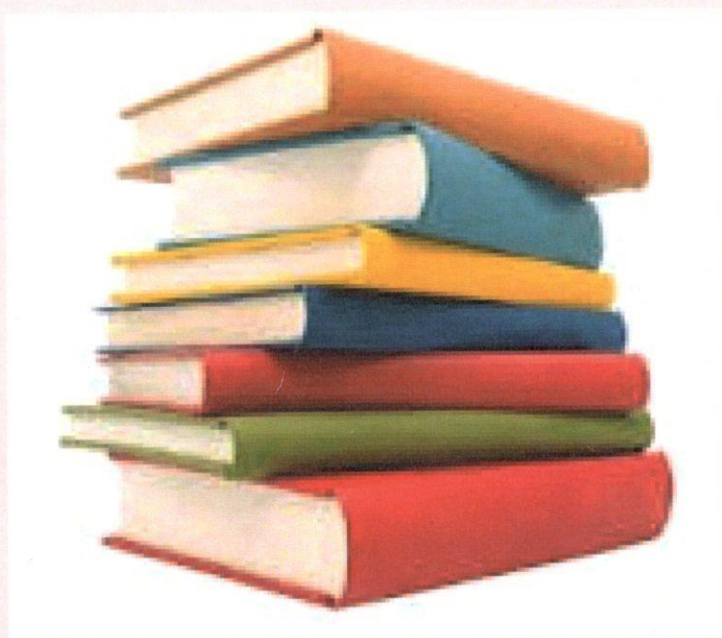

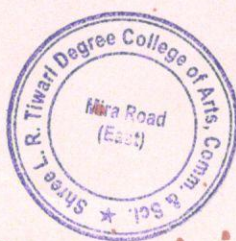
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

Session Objective:


- To foster appreciation and understanding of the Hindi language through engaging activities.

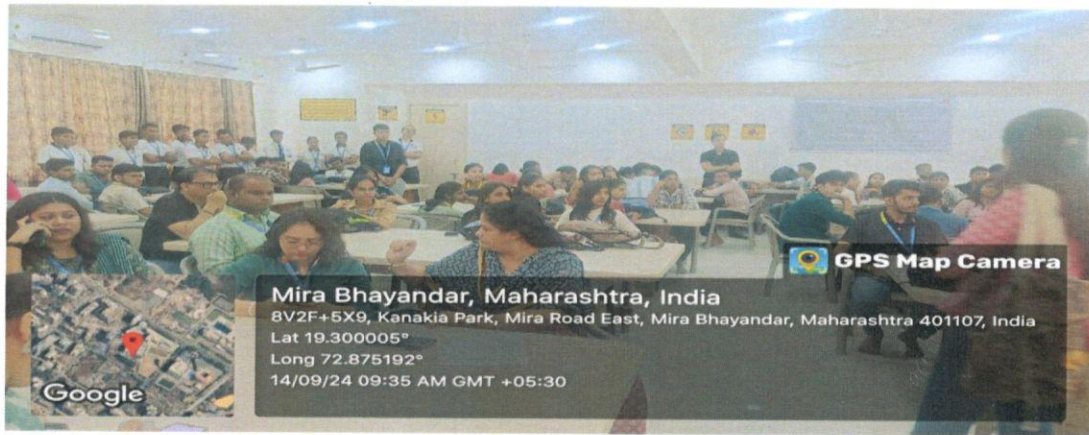
