Objective of the Session:

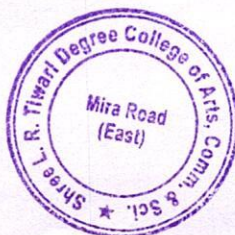
1. To guide students in understanding the fundamentals of academic research.

Q.1 How would you rate the effectiveness of Dr. Sanjay Mishra's presentation?

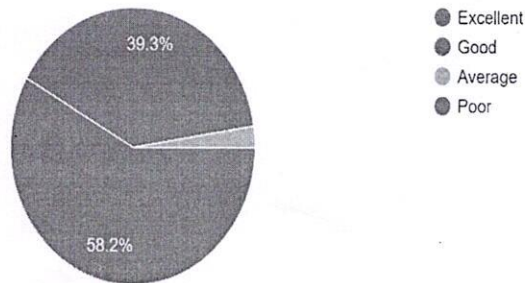

Q.2. How clear and understandable was the information provided by Dr. Sanjay Mishra?

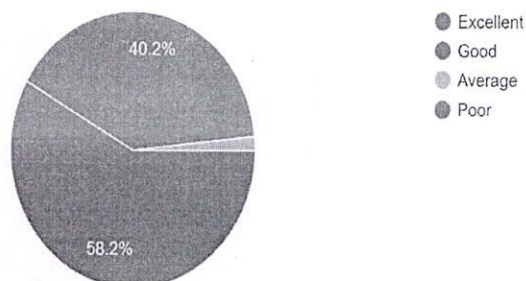

Q.3.How relevant was the content presented by Dr. Sanjay Mishra to your preparation?

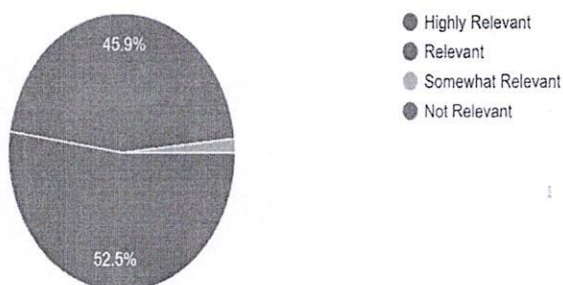

Q.4. How would you rate the overall quality of the session?

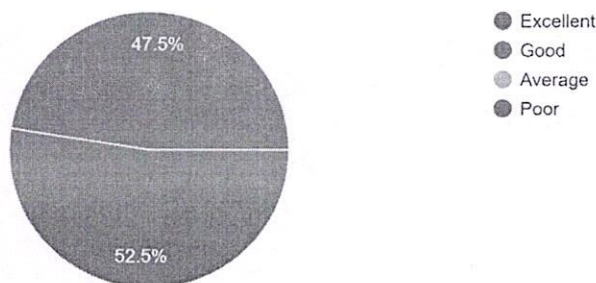

Q.5. How well did the session meet your expectations?

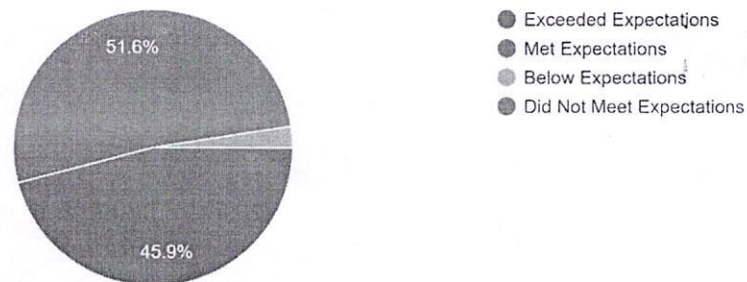

Q.6. How likely are you to recommend similar sessions to your peers?

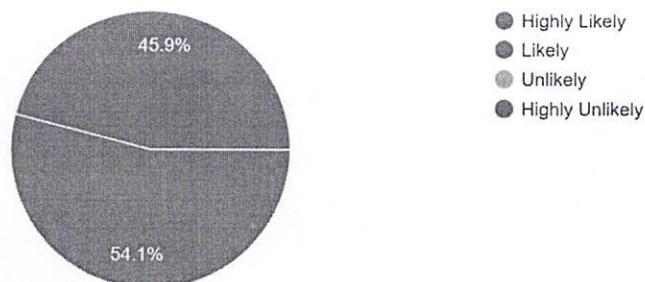
