- Avoid littering and respect nature


Itinerary for the trip is as follows:

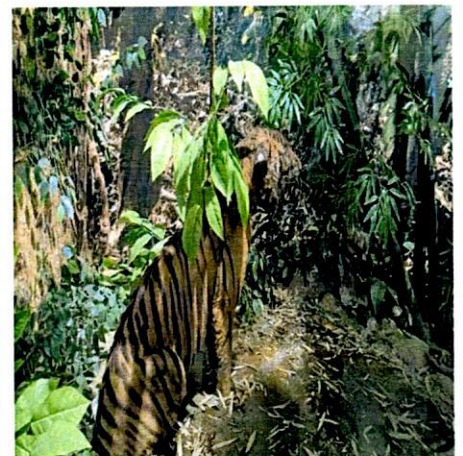
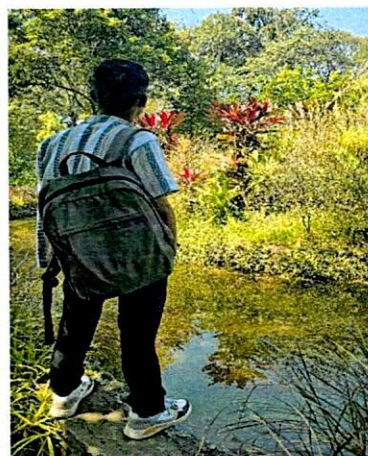
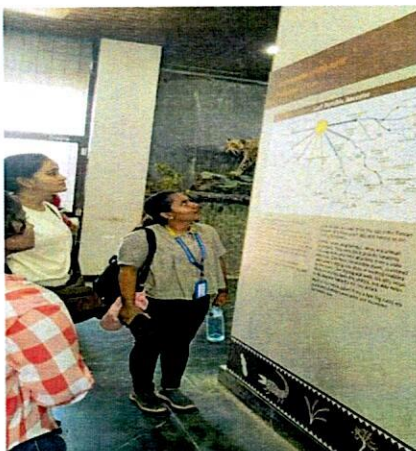
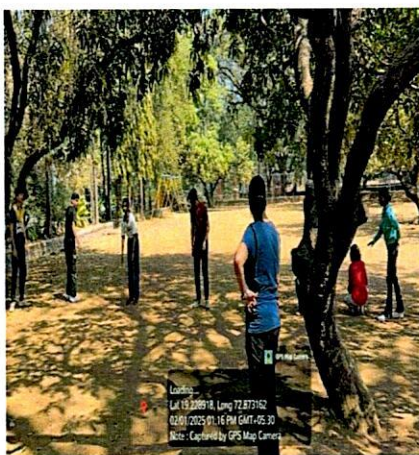
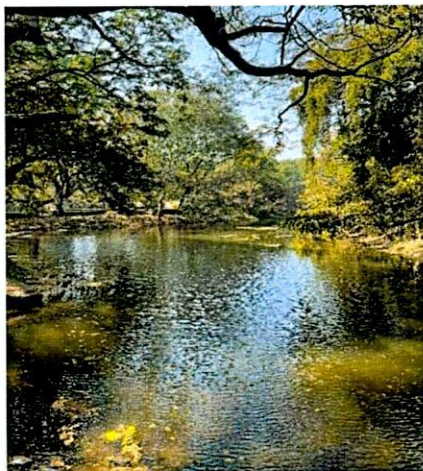
Cultural Activities
