



The Department of Commerce in Accounting and Finance of Shree L. R. Tiwari Degree College organized an Intra-Department Debate on the topic "New Income Tax Bill, 2025" on 26th June 2025. The debate saw enthusiastic participation from students of TYBAF and SYBAF.

The debate was structured to provide a platform for students to analyze and discuss the implications of the newly proposed Income Tax reforms. The event was judged by **Asst Prof. Suvarna Shende**, who shared valuable insights and encouraged students to strengthen their understanding of taxation and public policy.

The debate served as a valuable learning experience, allowing students to critically evaluate government reforms and present informed opinions. Both groups exhibited excellent preparation, clarity of thought, and confidence.

The event concluded with encouraging feedback from the judge, and the session was appreciated by faculty and attendees alike for its academic value and relevance.

The judge, Asst Prof. Suvarna Shende, announced Group A (SYBAF) as the winner of the debate competition. The team was appreciated for their well-structured arguments, critical analysis, and confident presentation against the New Income Tax Bill.

Conclusion by Asst. Prof. Saatish Pandey (Moderator):

Asst. Prof. Saatish Pandey appreciated the students for their participation and confident delivery. However, he pointed out a few key drawbacks observed during the debate:

- 1. **Inadequate use of sections and provisions**: Many participants presented arguments without quoting relevant sections of the Income Tax Bill, which weakened the legal and factual foundation of their points. He emphasized the importance of supporting arguments with specific clauses or provisions.
- 2. **Generalization of arguments**: Some students relied heavily on opinions or broad statements rather than data-driven points, and failed to distinguish between the old and proposed provisions of the bill.
- 3. Lack of structured flow and teamwork: A few teams lacked coordination in the flow of arguments, leading to repetition and inconsistent messaging.

He encouraged students to prepare with better technical references, including sections and real-world examples, to strengthen future performances.


