



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Day-wise Report:

Day 1 - 23rd June 2025 (Monday)

Session: College Orientation & Campus Round

The first day of the Orientation Week commenced with a warm welcome address by **Dr. Akanksha Gujrati Asar**, BAF Coordinator, who introduced the students to the Department of BAF and its academic structure. This was followed by a **College Orientation Session in the Auditorium**, conducted by **Principal Dr. Sanjay Mishra**, where students were familiarized with the college's **vision**, **mission**, **and core values**. 


