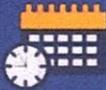

Highlights of the Session

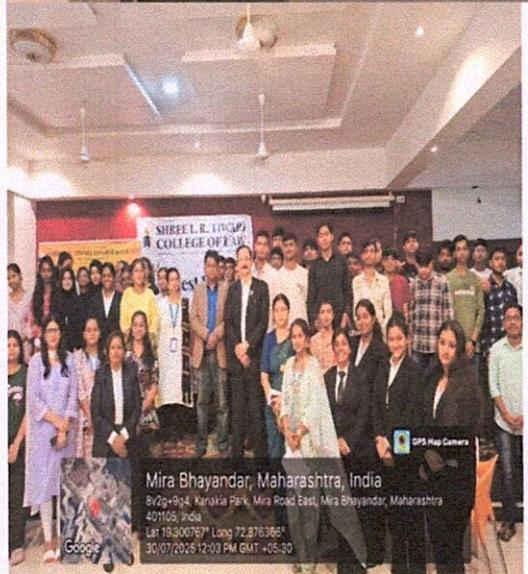
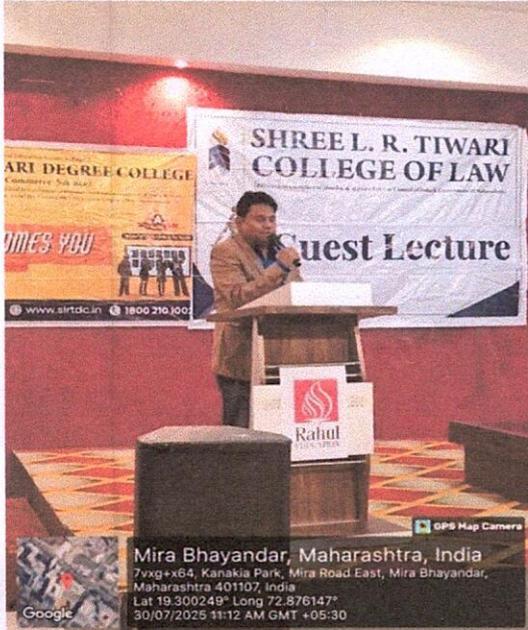

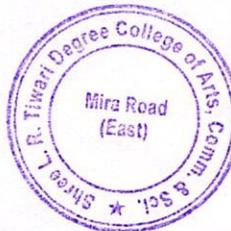
