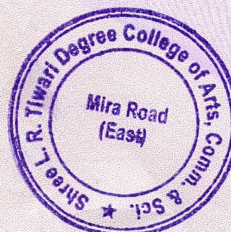


Objectives:


- To create awareness about cyber security threats such as online fraud, phishing, and identity theft.

- To encourage students to actively participate in community-based digital awareness initiatives.

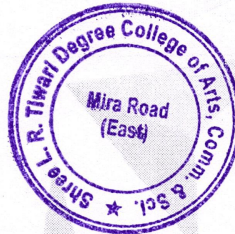


