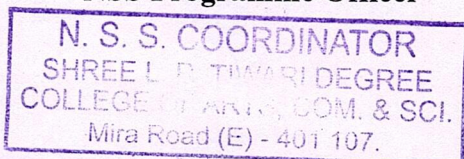

Outcomes:

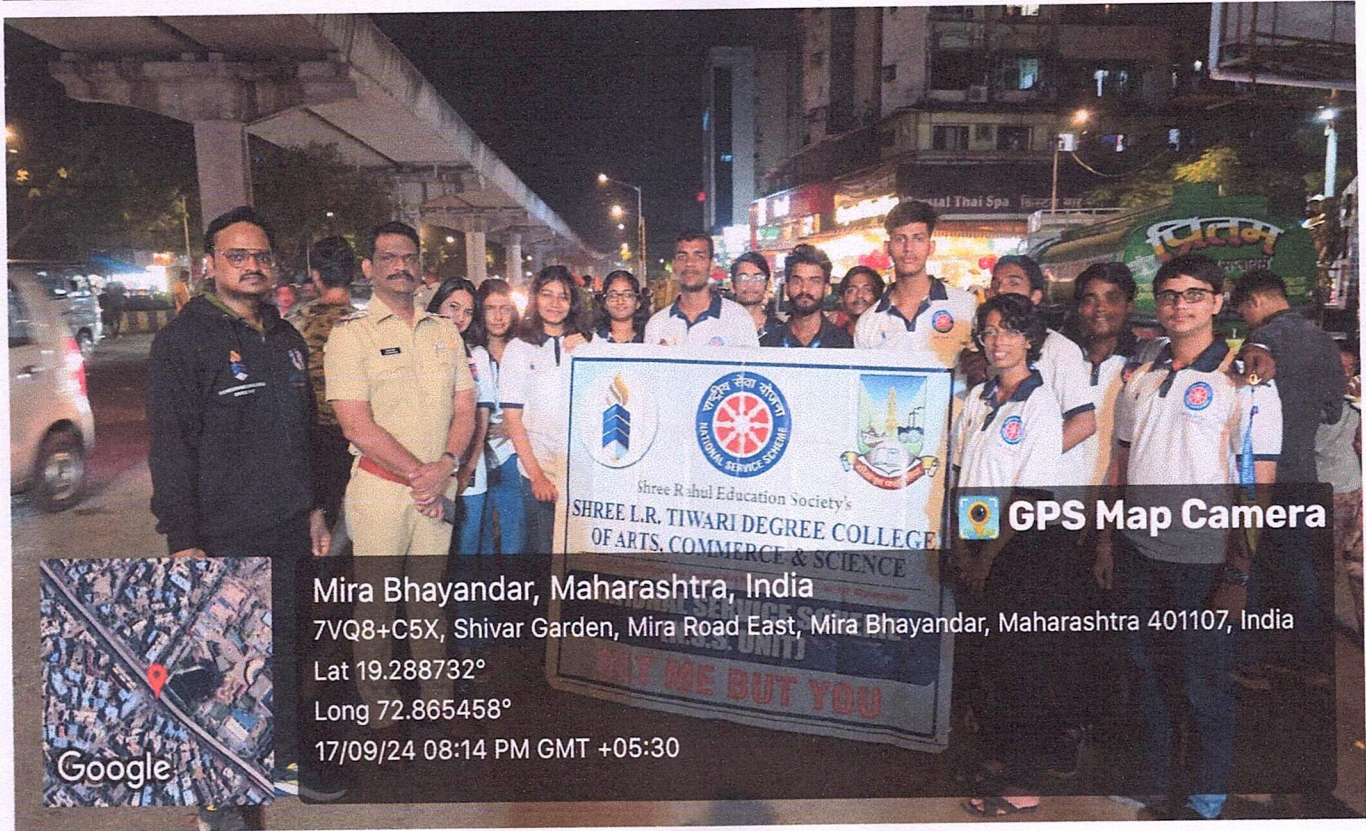
- Efficient vehicle flow with minimal congestion due to clear signage and designated parking areas.
