

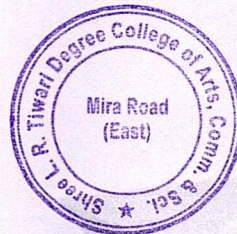


Objectives

Conclusion:



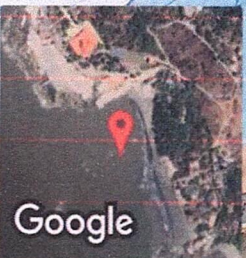
