

### Outcome:



- **Community Bonding:** Strengthened the relationship between students from various colleges and reinforced the values of harmony and collective service.


## Conclusion:

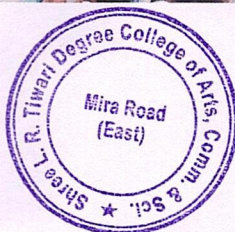
