



Outcome:

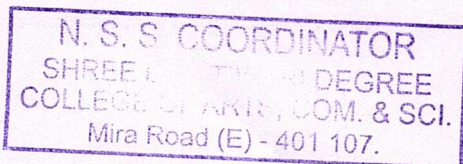
- Students understood the importance of supporting local businesses.
