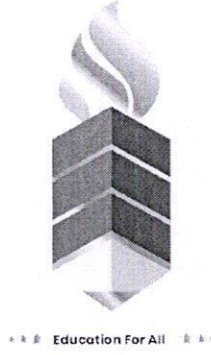

The program was conducted with the objective of bridging the gap between academics and industry by providing students with practical insights from an accomplished alumnus. The resource person for the session was Mr. Bharat P., a distinguished alumnus of the B.Sc. IT department, who shared his industry knowledge, experiences, and guidance with students.

Objectives of the Program

1. To provide students with practical insights, real-world experiences, and industry perspectives directly from accomplished alumni.
2. To support students in making informed career decisions by offering guidance on emerging career paths and skill requirements.
3. To strengthen the relationship between alumni and current students by creating an interactive platform for learning and mentorship.

Day 1: Resume and Career Readiness

The first day of the program focused on enhancing students' employability skills. Mr. Bharat P. delivered an insightful session on the importance of ATS (Applicant Tracking System)-friendly resumes, explaining how recruiters screen resumes and the common mistakes students should avoid.

Students were introduced to resume building using ChatGPT, where they learned how AI tools can be effectively used to structure resumes, frame impactful content, and customize resumes according to job descriptions. The session was interactive and helped students understand how to present their academic and technical skills professionally.

Highlights of the Event



Expected Outcomes


- Students gained clarity on resume optimization and the use of AI tools for career readiness.

- Strengthened alumni engagement and motivation among students to plan their career paths effectively.


Conclusion

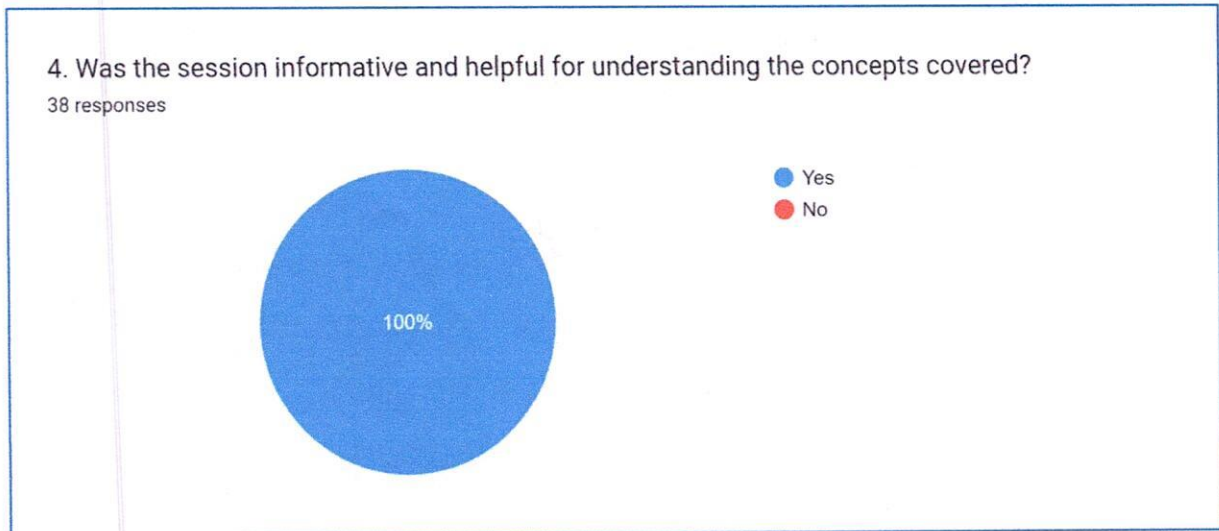
1. Was the session easy to understand and well-structured?

38 responses



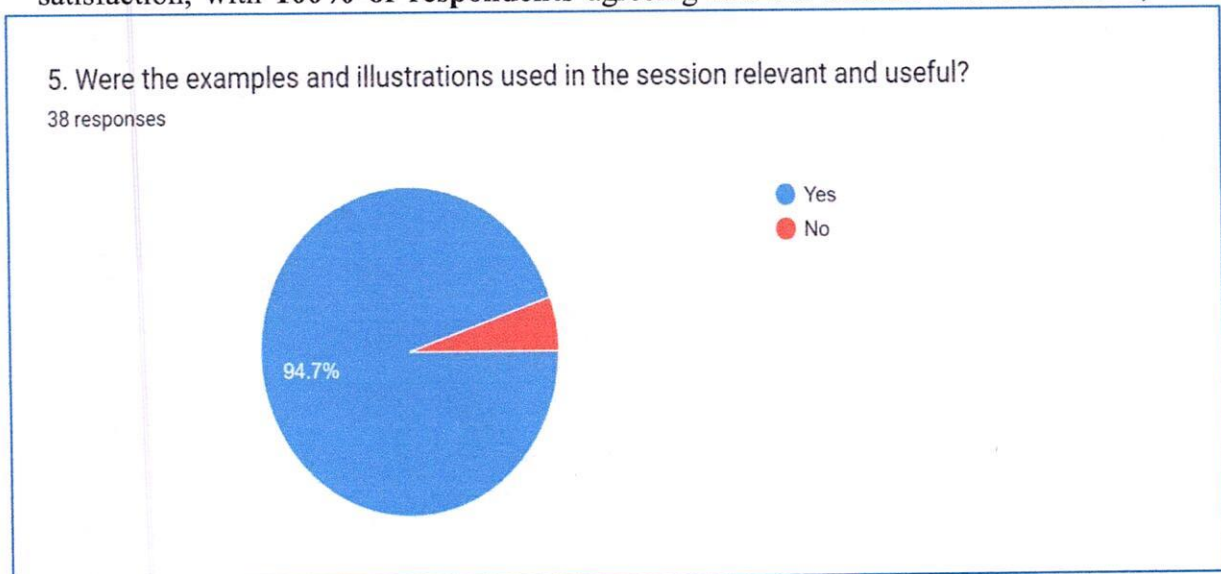

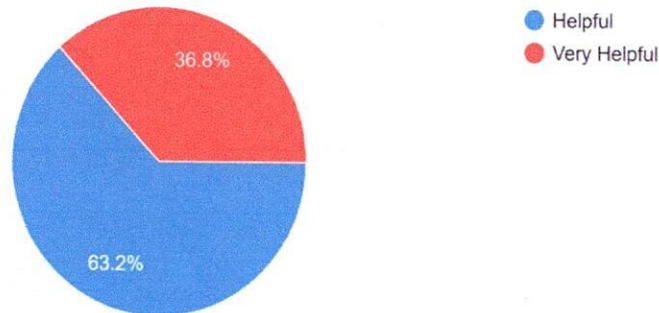

Areas for Improvement


- ✓ **Interactivity:** Shift from a lecture-only format to including more engaging activities.

Recommendations

- ✓ **Hands-on Workshops:** Transition to interactive sessions where students actively build professional profiles.
- ✓ **Time Management:** Extend session length to accommodate in-depth Q&A.
- ✓ **Detailed Modules:** Provide specific guidance on LinkedIn optimization and resume drafting.

Conclusion

The "Anubhav" session was highly effective, with 100% of participants praising the structure and methodology. While the session successfully bridged the industry-academia gap, future iterations should incorporate more practical, hands-on activities to maximize student career readiness.
