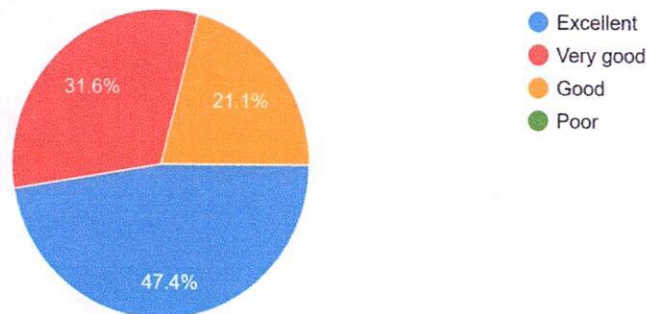

1. How was the overall session on the Union Budget?

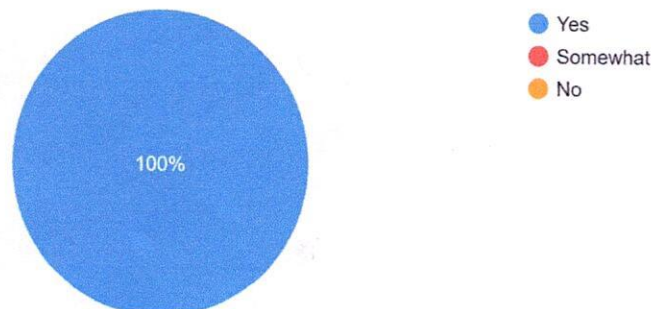
19 responses

18 responses

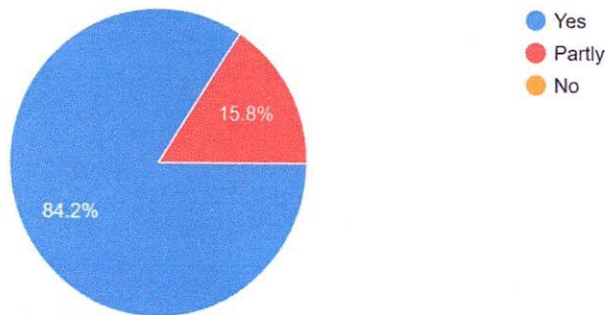




A majority of respondents indicated that the content was **easy to understand**, while a few students selected **Somewhat**, suggesting that the explanations were largely clear and accessible.

3. Did the session help you understand the key points of the Union Budget?

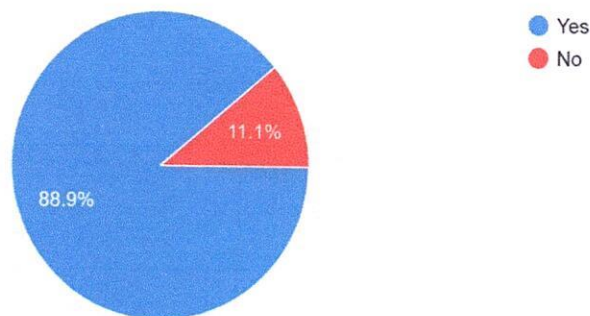
19 responses

The majority of participants felt that **sufficient time** was provided to explain important topics related to the Union Budget, allowing for better comprehension and discussion.

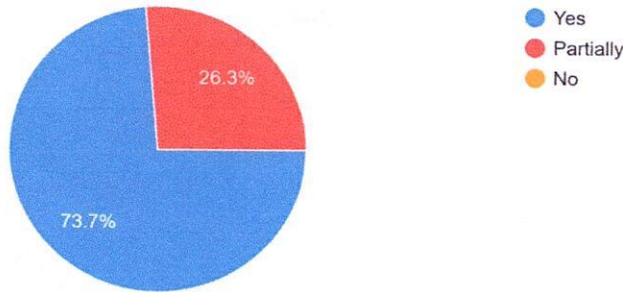

5. Were the explanations regarding implications on corporate taxation, MSMEs, financial markets, and public expenditure adequately addressed?

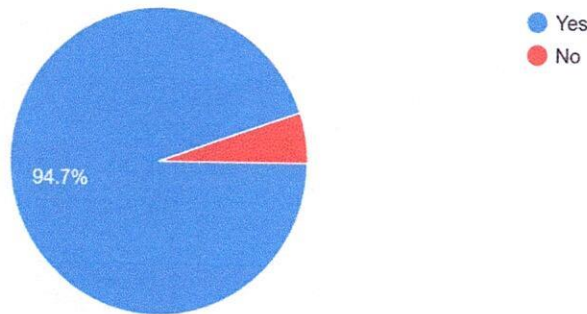
19 responses
