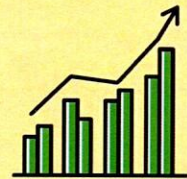

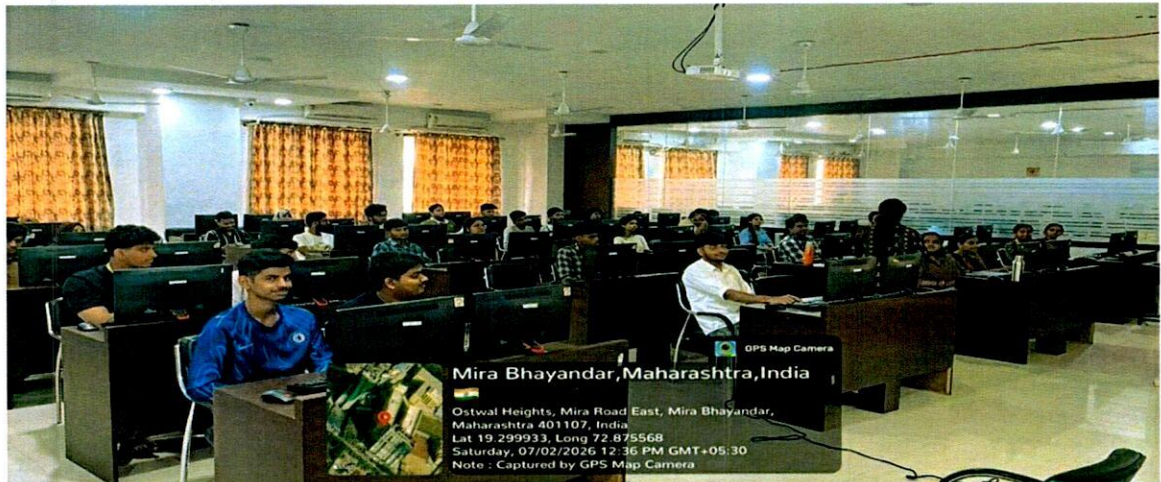

1. Overall Response
