Incharge person: Student Managers- Rohit Suthar and Kalika Tambat.

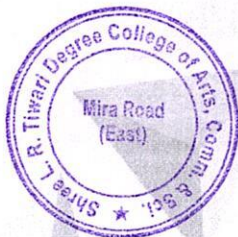

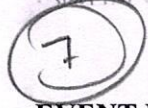
