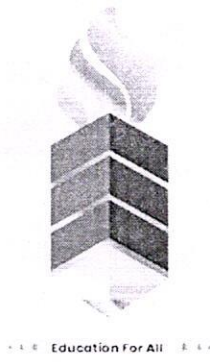

Objectives:

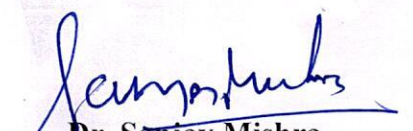
- To understand the functioning and structure of radio broadcasting at a national public service broadcaster.

- To explore the role of All India Radio in promoting cultural, educational, and informational content across diverse audiences.

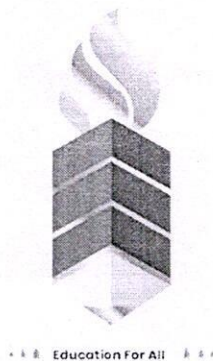

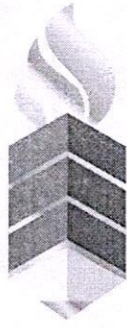

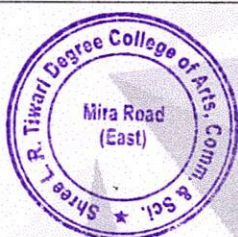

Learning Outcomes:

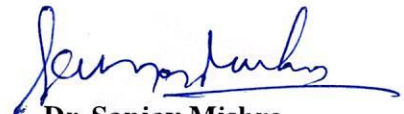
- Enhanced understanding of radio programming and broadcasting workflows.
