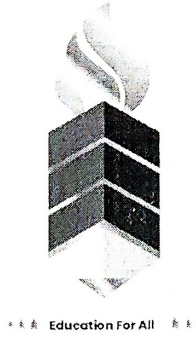

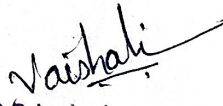

Detailed Description of the Session
