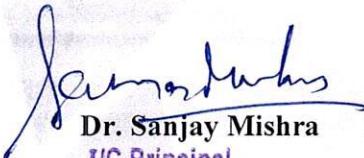

- Students gained a **clear understanding of the CMA course**, its eligibility requirements, examination pattern, and study strategies.





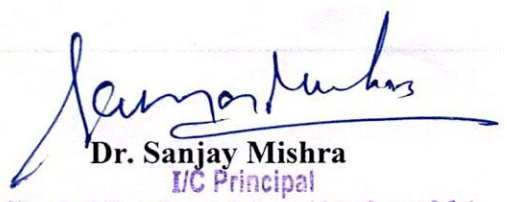
- The session created a **greater awareness about the scope and significance** of Cost and Management Accounting in corporate and government sectors.

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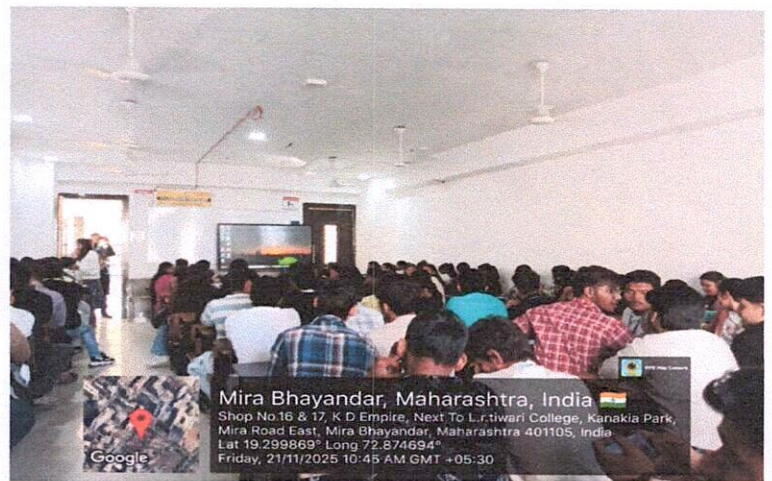

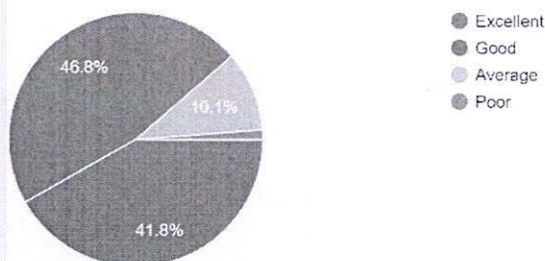

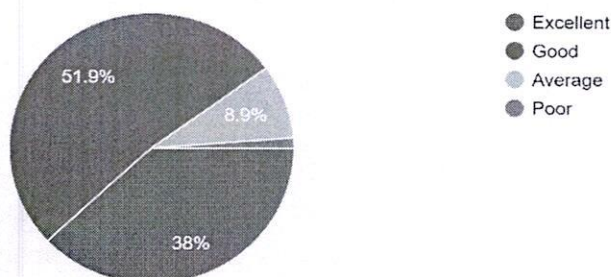
Feedback Report

How would you rate the effectiveness of CMA. Binoy Thomas's presentation?



The feedback indicates that CMA Binoy Thomas's presentation was highly effective. A majority of the students rated it positively, with 42.5% marking it as Excellent and 45.5% rating it as Good, showing strong appreciation for the clarity and usefulness of the session. Only 11% of the students considered it Average, suggesting room for minor improvements. A very small proportion, 1.4%, rated the presentation as Poor, indicating that almost all participants found value in the session. Overall, the responses reflect a high level of engagement, effective content delivery, and strong communication by the speaker. The analysis clearly shows that the presentation successfully met the expectations of most students.

How clear and understandable was the information provided by CMA. Binoy Thomas?

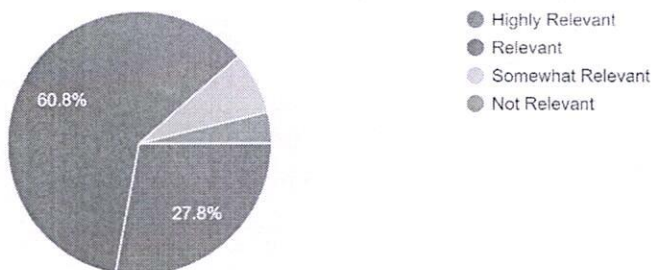


The clarity and understandability of the information provided by CMA Binoy Thomas were rated very positively by participants. A strong majority, 89.3%, marked the presentation as either Excellent (40%) or Good (49.3%), indicating that the content was communicated effectively and was easy to follow. Only 9.3% of respondents felt the clarity was Average, suggesting limited areas for refinement. A minimal 1.3% rated it as Poor, showing very low dissatisfaction. Overall, the feedback reflects that the information was delivered in a clear, structured, and highly comprehensible manner.



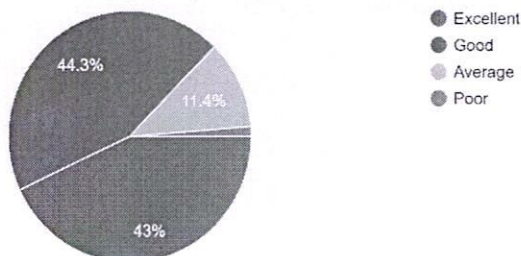


How relevant was the content presented by CMA. Binoy Thomas to your preparation?



The feedback indicates that the content delivered by CMA Binoy Thomas was highly aligned with students' preparation needs. A significant majority found the session either Highly Relevant (29.3%) or Relevant (58.7%), showing that over 88% of participants felt the content effectively supported their academic and career goals. Only a small proportion rated it as Somewhat Relevant (8%), reflecting minor gaps in specific areas of interest. The Not Relevant response of 4% suggests that a very limited group felt the content did not match their expectations. Overall, the analysis demonstrates that the session was well-designed, informative, and beneficial for most students.

How would you rate the overall quality of the session?

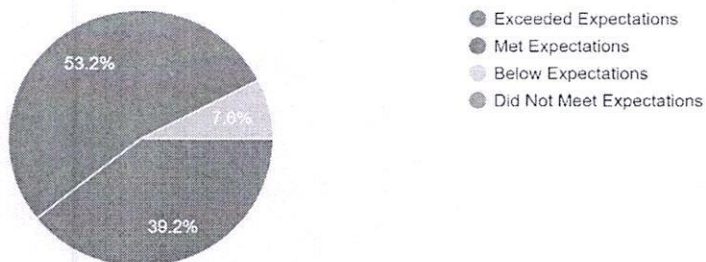


The overall quality of the session received highly positive feedback from the participants. A combined 86.7% rated the session as either Excellent (44%) or Good (42.7%), indicating that the delivery, content, and engagement were well-received. The Average rating of 12% shows that some participants felt the session met expectations but had scope for improvement. A minimal Poor rating of 1.3% reflects that only a very small portion of the audience was dissatisfied. Overall, the results highlight that the session was effective, informative, and impactful for the majority of students.



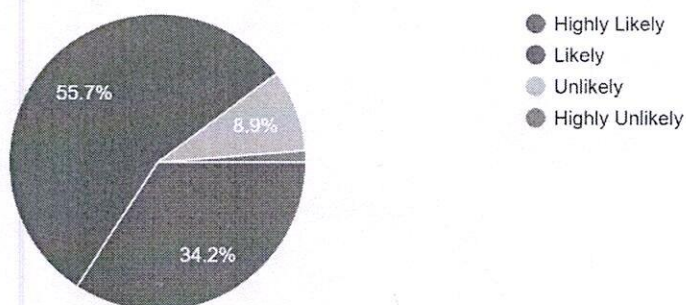


How well did the session meet your expectations?



The feedback shows that the session successfully met the expectations of most participants. A strong 41.3% felt the session Exceeded Expectations, highlighting the speaker's effective delivery and valuable insights. Additionally, 50.7% reported that the session Met Expectations, indicating that the content and presentation aligned well with what students anticipated. Only 8% rated it as Below Expectations, suggesting minor areas where improvements could be made. A small 5% felt the session Did Not Meet Expectations, representing a limited group with unmet needs. Overall, the results reflect that the session was impactful, informative, and largely well-received by students.

How likely are you to recommend similar sessions to your peers?



The responses indicate a strong willingness among participants to recommend similar sessions to their peers. A significant majority rated their likelihood as Highly Likely (36%) or Likely (53.3%), showing that nearly 90% found the session valuable and worth sharing. This suggests that the content, delivery, and relevance of the session created a positive learning experience. Only 9.3% reported being Unlikely to recommend it, while a very small 1.3% were Highly Unlikely, indicating minimal dissatisfaction. Overall, the feedback reflects high participant satisfaction and strong endorsement potential for future sessions.

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
