Objectives of the Session:

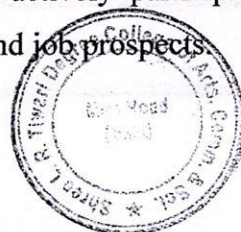
The primary objectives of the session were:

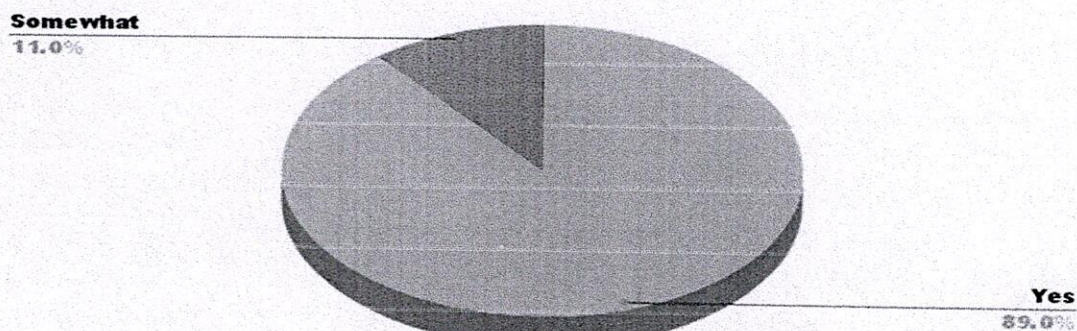

Count on Clarity of Career in Securities Market Explanation

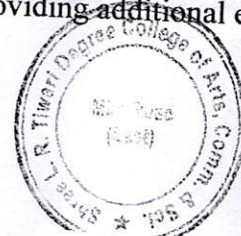


Key Observations:

- **"Yes" (Blue) - 89%:** The vast majority of respondents found the explanation clear and easy to follow.
- **"Somewhat" (Red) - 11%:** A small percentage of respondents found the explanation only somewhat clear, indicating some level of confusion or need for further clarification.
- **No responses indicating "No":** This suggests that no one found the explanation completely unclear.

Interpretation:

The results indicate that the explanation was generally well-received, with a **high level of clarity** for most respondents. However, the 11% **"Somewhat"** response suggests room for **improvement**, possibly in simplifying complex concepts or providing additional examples.



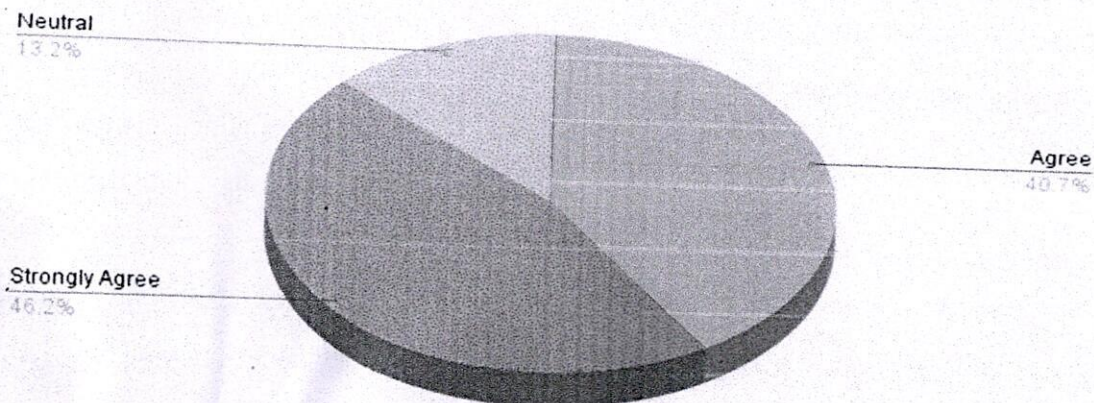


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2. Count on Understanding of Session Objectives

Key Observations:

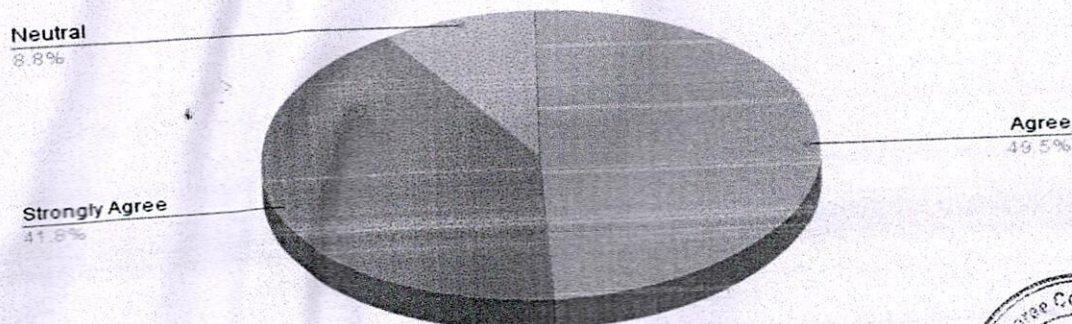
- **Strongly Agree (Red) - 46.2%:** Nearly half of the participants strongly agreed that the session objectives were clearly identified.

Key Observations:

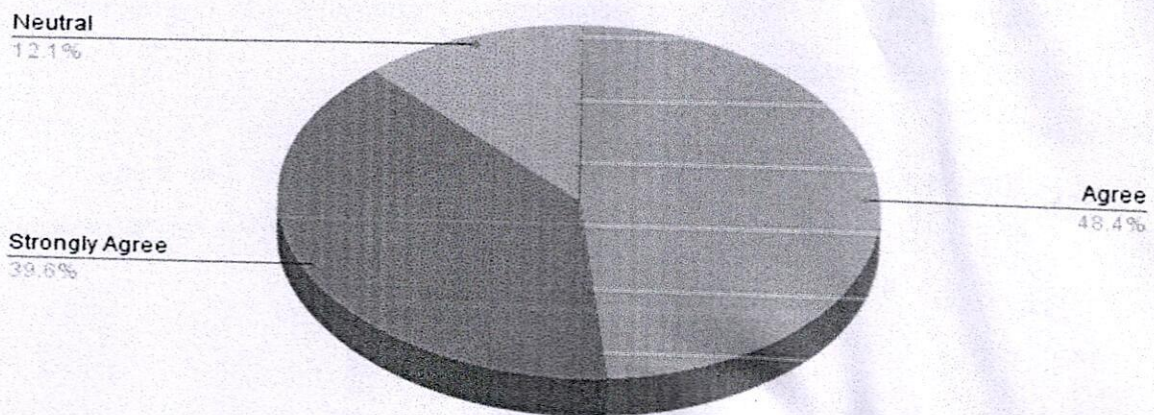
- **Agree (Blue) - 49.5%:** Nearly half of the respondents agreed that the topics covered aligned well with the session title.

- **Neutral (Yellow) - 8.8%:** A small percentage of attendees remained neutral, indicating they were unsure or had mixed opinions about the alignment of topics with the session title.

Interpretation:

The session was **highly relevant** to its title, with most attendees affirming its alignment. However, to address the **neutral responses**, facilitators might consider **ensuring clearer topic alignment** by explicitly linking discussions to the session's title or checking for expectations beforehand.

4. Count on Clarity and Organization of Session Content

- **48.4% Agree (Blue segment):** A majority of respondents believe the session content was clear and well-organized.
- **39.6% Strongly Agree (Red segment):** A significant portion strongly agrees that the content was well-structured.
- **12.1% Neutral (Yellow segment):** A small percentage neither agreed nor disagreed, suggesting some room for improvement.

Interpretation:





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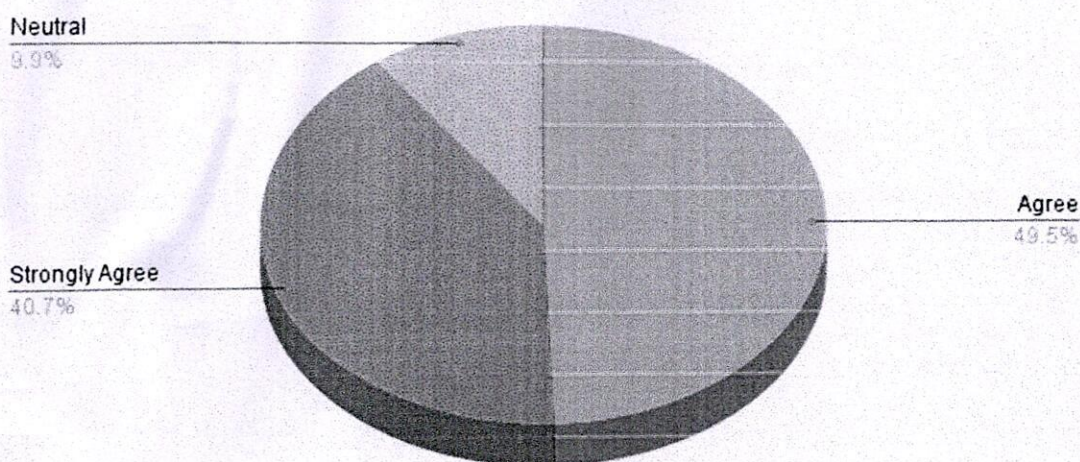
The overall feedback is positive, with **88% (Agree + Strongly Agree)** of participants finding the session content clear and well-organized.

The overall positive response (**Agree + Strongly Agree**) is **90.2%**, indicating that the resource person was well-received.

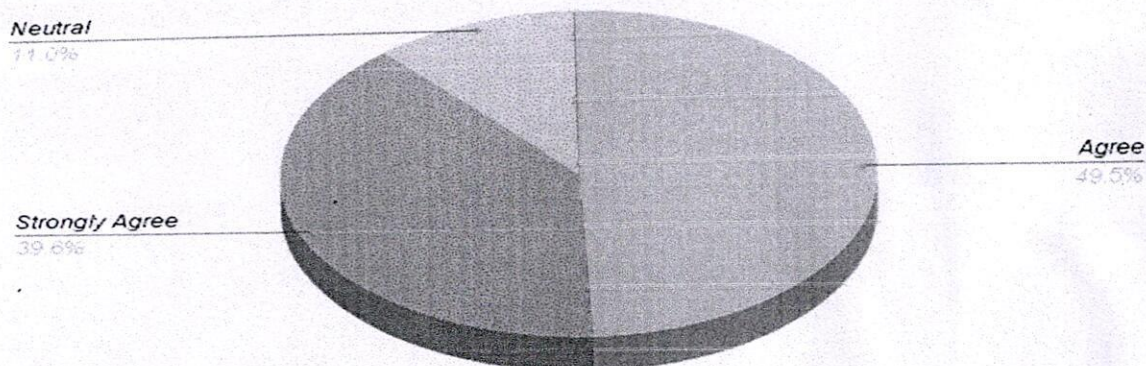

The **Neutral response (11%)** suggests that a few participants might have expected more engagement opportunities.

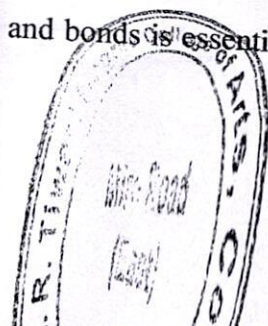
Since **no negative responses** are present (e.g., Disagree or Strongly Disagree), it indicates that interaction was generally well-facilitated.

CONCLUSION:

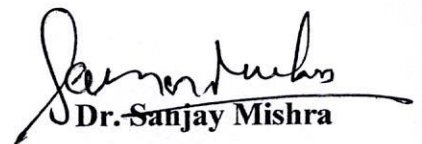
