Report on Orientation Program for FYBAMMC Students

Date: 26th June

Venue: Classroom No. 101, Old Building

Conducted by: Asst. Prof. Moumita Nath (Coordinator, BAMMC Department)

An orientation session was conducted for the First Year (FYBAMMC) students of the BAMMC department. The session was led by Asst. Prof. Moumita Nath, the department coordinator, aimed to familiarize students with the academic structure, National Education Policy (NEP) guidelines, departmental expectations, and overall student responsibilities for the new academic year.

Key Highlights of the Orientation:

NEP Degree Structure & Exit Options:

Examination Pattern:

The evaluation pattern under NEP guidelines, Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE), and the importance of regular attendance and active participation were emphasized.





Faculty Introduction:

The faculty members for various subjects were introduced. Students were informed about their subject teachers, and mentors. Faculty availability, teaching methodology, and support mechanisms were shared to ensure academic guidance throughout the year.

Department Achievements and Past Events:

Students were given glimpses of departmental achievements, including successful events like field visits, workshops, seminars, and intercollegiate competitions. Active student participation and recognitions in academic and co-curricular activities were appreciated.

Discipline, Code of Conduct, and Anti-Ragging Policy:

Students were informed in detail about the college's code of conduct, including expected discipline, punctuality, dress code, and respectful behavior on campus. - Students were empowered to plan their academic journey with clarity, keeping both short-term and long-term goals in mind.





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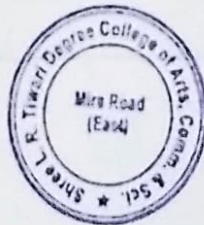
Conclusion:
