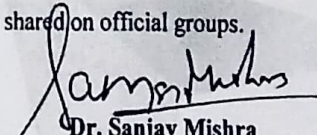

Career and Higher Studies Guidance:

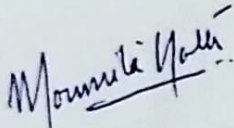
Students were motivated to plan for higher education and certifications in emerging technologies. The importance of internships and project work in building resumes and skillsets was stressed.

Outcomes of the Orientation:

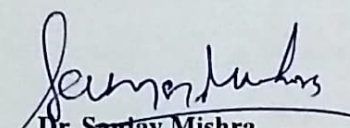
- Students gained a clear understanding of the syllabus, academic structure, and subject requirements.

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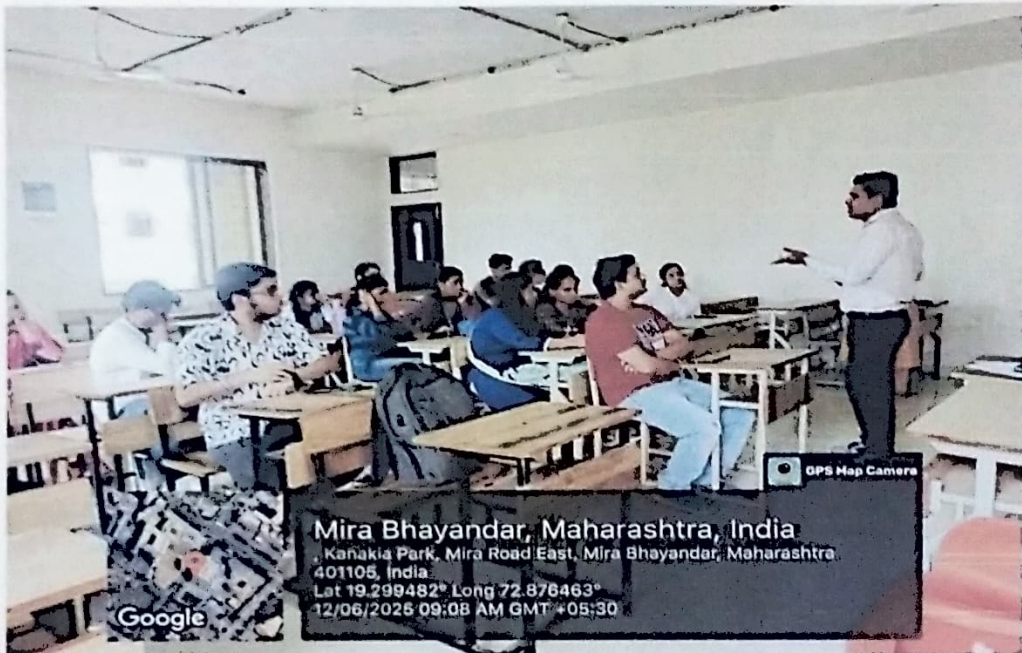
